Fisher House Foundation is best known for a network of comfort homes where military and veterans' families can stay at no cost while a loved one is receiving treatment.

- These [homes are located](#) at major military and VA medical centers nationwide, close to the medical center or hospital they serve. [Fisher Houses](#) have up to 21 suites, with private bedrooms and baths. Families share a common kitchen, laundry facilities, a warm dining room and an inviting living room. Fisher House Foundation ensures that there is never a lodging fee. Since inception, the

program has saved military and veterans' families an estimated \$235 million in out of pocket costs for lodging and transportation.

Fisher House Foundation also operates the [Hero Miles program](#), using donated frequent flyer miles to bring family members to the bedside of injured service members as well as the [Hotels for Heroes program](#) using donated hotel points to allow family members to stay at hotels near medical centers without charge. The Foundation also manages a [grant program](#) that supports other military charities and [scholarship funds](#) for military children, spouses and children of fallen and disabled veterans.

- Families served: More than 25,000 in 2014
- Daily capacity: 848 families
- Families served: More than 250,000 since inception
- Number of lodging days offered: Over 5.5 million
- 7,000 students have received \$11,000,000 in scholarship awards
- Over 50,000 airline tickets provided by Hero Miles to service members and their families, worth nearly \$73 million
