Ukraine Assistance Program Changes Lives

On 22 November, Oksana, her husband Oleg, daughter Nastya, and twin three-yearolds Bohdan and Roman landed at O'Hare airport in Chicago. After the few hours it took us to navigate customs and drive to Dixon, they opened the door to their new apartment. cludes several members of the Rotary Club It had been graciously donated by Katherine Shaw Bethea Hospital and beautifully furnished and decorated by part of the team that formed to save two Ukrainian families from Russia's brutal invasion.
