Valerie Pelan recognized the members of the Membership Team. This team consists of the Membership Recruitment Team, the Membership Interview Team, the New Member Engagement/Mentoring Team, and the New member Orientation Team. All of these teams assist the new members, and all welcome additional club members to join them.

PP **Fred Brown** gave his Membership Minute. He credited PP **Phillip Bankhead**, PP **Cleve Clinton** and PP **Rod Pirtle** as involving him in Royary nineteen years ago. When he became President he said he had a strong Board, many of whom became Presidents of the club. He got to attend the RI Convention in Bangkok. He recalled that it was a great year and received the Club of the Year award. He encouraged the new members to talk to the Past Presidents for ideas to get involved.

President **Happy** invited us to attend the District Conference and Awards Banquet on April 22-23. She said that the club had submitted eighteen award nominations.



Jeff Sheehan introduced our speaker to-day, **Dan Bailey**, the Founder and CEO of Just Say YES. He began by saying that he was a member of the Preston Center RC. He said he would talk about what is happening in the youth culture today and the pressures that young people are facing. He said why he does what he does is that he grew up with an angry, aggressive stepfather, so he knows what it is like to be isolated and alone. He started volunteering in schools, and in 1999 he resigned from his business career to work with young people. Two and a half years later he founded Just Say Yes. Young people are facing the pressures of drugs, social media, mental health issues and depression. One in five students have been bullied in schools. Students are getting expelled for sexting. Children of teen mothers have lower achievement and higher dropout rates. One in six teens, aged fourteen through eighteen, have created a personal suicide plan. We don't know the full impact of the pandemic, and its isolation or the masking of young children. The mission of Just Say Yes is growing value and vision in youth by combating isolation and imparting hope. He has twenty people on his staff who are passionate about connecting. "A connected student is a protected student." They want to help students form positive connections with peers, parents and teachers. They have specific programs for different age groups for bullying, social media, etc. They contract with motivational speakers for assemblies. They have eight wellness education speakers on staff. They speak in schools to about fifty students at a time. They also have peer to peer mentoring. Counselors select juniors and seniors, who receive training to mentor freshman students. This is in eight high schools.
