Why Rotary Is Growing in Ukraine During a War excerpted from Rotary Voices

Membership has grown 23.5% in Ukraine since Russian forces invaded the country on February 24, 2022. The region, which comprises Rotary District 2232, has added four Rotary clubs and five satellite clubs.

The clubs in Ukraine became more visible in their communities in the days and months after the war began. People are wit-nessing the positive impact members are having and want to join in on making a dif-ference.

One club, for example, had their members learn to become volunteer firefighters so they could help put out fires, literally, when local building are hit by shelling.

People were drawn to the opportunity to find meaning and purpose when they see real positive change taking place.

We conclude that no one joins a club to sit around and do nothing. People join because they want to become engaged with a cause and do something real. Rotary matters and engaging members in service matters.

In a recent conversation with a group of professional peacebuilders, one of my colleagues (and a new Rotary member) surprised me when he referred to Rotary as a "disruptor for peace." A disruptor for peace? That was something new and unexpected.
