## Dale Hansen, Sports Anchor, WFAA 8

Dale Hansen is the weeknight sports anchor during the 10 p.m. newscast on WFAA, Channel 8 in Dallas Texas. He also hosts Dale Hansen's Sports Special on Sundays at 10:35 p.m.. He's well known for his acclaimed "Unplugged" segments.

Hansen began his career as a radio disc jockey and operations manager in Newton, Iowa. This was followed by a job as a sports reporter at KMTV in Omaha. Nebraska. Hansen's first job in Dallas was with KDFW-TV (Channel 4). He joined WFAA-TV in 1983.

In 1987, Hansen was honored with the George Foster Peabody Award for Distinguished Journalism. That same year, he won the duPont-Columbia Award for his contribution to the investigation of SMU's football program. As a result of this investigation. the NCAA prohibited SMU from fielding a football program in 1987. Hansen is the only local on-air broadcaster who has received the Radio Television Digital News Foundation's Lifetime Achievement Award, which he received in 2019.

Hansen has been featured in The New York Times, The Washington Post, and on the Ellen Degeneres Show.

and part of that is writing a book. He has had a full-time private practice since 2003. One of his core beliefs is that "life is hard, so we have many opportunities to grow and learn." He believes that whatever adjustment life is asking.



our job is to grow into it. His job in psychotherapy is to help people complete the journey. He feels that everyone is doing the best thing they can do. When he started in his geriatric practice, he always talked to the adult children of his clients, and they always described their parents as "hell on wheels." The children had been learning strategies for coping and improving. He compiled all of the strategies the adult children had learned into a pattern of insights and skills. He has found six different parent scenarios. If the parents have been difficult for a long time, they may have personality disorders. These parents show intrusiveness, laziness, blaming and criticizing, dishonesty, irresponsibility, trusting strangers over family, and showing an innocent facade. Older people with cognitive impairment show repetitiveness, restlessness, wandering, delusions, aggressiveness and withdrawal. The three goals of their children are to protect their heart, to effectively love their older parent, and to leave a legacy for their own children. He has identified strategies for each of these goals, ten strategies to empower the mind, ten to comfort the heart and ten to guide your actions. We grow through life in stages: transitions can be easy or terrifying, but every one is comprised of cognition, emotion and behavior. Everyone must learn new skills, recognize their emotions, and change their behaviors to do the work. Everyone's personality is a blend of nature, nurture and choices.
