Pia M. Orrenius, VP and Senior Economist Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas

Pia Orrenius is a labor economist, working on regional economic growth and demographic change. She manages the regional and microeconomics group in the Dallas Fed Research Department, is executive editor of the publication *Southwest Economy* and co-edited *Ten Gallon Economy: Sizing up Economic Growth in Texas* (2015, Palgrave MacMillan).

Her academic research focuses on the labor market impacts of immigration, unauthorized immigration and U.S. immigration policy. She is coauthor of the book *Beside the Golden Door: U.S. Immigration Reform in a New Era of Globalization* (2010, AEI Press).

Orrenius is affiliated with several academic institutions. She

is research fellow at the Tower Center for Public Policy and International Affairs and the Mission Foods Texas-Mexico Center at Southern Methodist University and at the IZA Institute of Labor in Bonn, Germany, as well as adjunct scholar at the American Enterprise Institute.

Orrenius was senior economist on the Council of Economic Advisers in the Executive Office of the President, Washington D.C., in 2004–05, where she advised the Bush administration on labor, health and immigration issues.

She holds a PhD in economics from the University of California at Los Angeles and bachelor degrees in economics and Spanish from the University of Illinois at Urbana—Champaign.

PP Richard Stanford introduced our speaker today, The Honorable Kay Bailey Hutchison. She has had a fifty year career in public service. Most recently, she has been the ambassador to NATO. She said that her husband Ray has been gone for ten years, but that his imprint is all over Dallas. She said her father started the Rotary Club in her home town. She said she never thought about being an ambassador when she was in the Senate. She was asked to be an ambassador when President Trump was first elected. She said she was so glad that she accepted the post. She said she felt like she was able to hold our coalition together with the USA as the leader. A lot of people don't understand that the USA needs to be the leader of NATO. Europeans don't think like we do. Security is our first priority. We redo our risk assessment every ten years in the Department of Defense. We know saries. We deter against the risk. The great thing about NATO is that we are not gearing up against potential adversaries alone. We are speaking with almost thirty-two voices when Sweden comes in. If one of the countries is invaded by a hostile force, then all will come in to fight for the freedom of that country. NATO speaks with thirty-one voices, but there are forty official partners. In Afghanistan we has a coalition of seventy countries. With allies the cost is shared and we all have the same goal of keeping freedom as the way of life.
