**Mark A. Wynne, Assoc. Dir. of Research and
Director of the Globalization Institute,
Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas**

Update on the 2022 Economy

Mark A. Wynne is a vice president, associate director of Research and director of the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas' Globalization Institute.

Since joining the Dallas Fed in 1989, he has had a variety of responsibilities, including advising the Bank's president on national and international economic conditions prior to meetings of the Federal Open Market Committee, briefing the Bank's board of directors and leading the Bank's international economics group. He has conducted research on the effects of fiscal policy, the drivers of business cycles, inflation measurement, the regional impact of global shocks, the natural rate of interest and the workings of monetary unions, among other topics. His research has appeared in many of the leading peer-reviewed academic journals and Federal Reserve publications. He co-

edited the volume *The Federal Reserve's Role in the Global Economy: A Historical Perspective* with Michael D. Bordo, which was published by Cambridge University Press in 2016.

Wynne has taught at University College Dublin, the University of Rochester, Southern Methodist University and the University of Texas at Dallas.

He is a member of the American Economic Association, the European Economic Association, the Econometric Society, the Council on Foreign Relations and the Dallas Committee on Foreign Relations.

He earned first-class-honors BA and MA degrees from the National University of Ireland—University College, Dublin, and holds MA and PhD degrees in economics from the University of Rochester.

It has been a great opportunity to meet people and form relationships. They have already started working on the Grand Marshal, and soon she will be asking for suggestions for the theme for the 2022 Parade.

colleagues with him. He began by explaining that centers in Dallas County that are open from eight to five everyday. He is an outreach specialist. Their mission is to help employees, people who are looking for jobs. They invite employers to come to the centers to have one-to-one interviews. They also have online workshops, and have xeroxes, telephones, faxes and computers available for their clients to use. They try to match employees with employers. Their RISE program provides virtual workshops in a variety of topics, like resume writing, interview skills, job training, etc. They try to work with people wherever they are. They have services for young adult, aged 16 to 24, who are not in high school. They provide mentoring and scholarships for training and programs to get the GED. They also have vocational rehab for persons with disabilities. They help them to get what they need to get a job. They have access to over five thousand courses to enhance skills. A lot of entry level jobs are being lost due to technology, but enhancing skills will make job seekers more employable. They have courses in things like Excel, Powerpoint, Publisher, etc. They also have classes for the GED, classes for English as a Second Language (ESL) and career transitions. Clients can apply for childcare and transportation if they are accepted into the program. They have a program for veterans, realizing that veterans have different skills and experiences than civilians. The job market can be divided into several sectors, the trades, transportation, logistics and utilities sector, the professional services sector, the Education and Health sector, the Government sector, and the Leisure and Hospitality Sector. They emphasize the benefits of employment: developing new skills, eligibility for earned income tax credits, financial independence, positive self-esteem and the opportunity to build a career.
