# Dallas Cothrum, Planning and Zoning in Dallas

Dr. Cothrum is an expert in land use, zoning, permitting, and lobbying and he represents clients ranging from local schools. neighborhoods, and public agencies to billion-dollar companies. He currently serves as President of Masterplan, a Milrose Company, and LaBarba Permit Service, leading an accomplished team of consultants with a track record of creating success for their clients.

Dr. Cothrum typically assists clients from due diligence and site selection through the entire zoning and building permit process, culminating with a certificate of occupancy. Throughout his career, he has worked on numerous politically charged and technically difficult cases. He directed the efforts on Rosewood Court, many types of multi-family projects, and self-storage locations. Over the past decade he has worked more cases in Oaklawn and

Dallas Uptown than any other.

Formerly, he was a tenured professor in the University of Texas System. He received a doctorate from Texas Christian University and completed postdoctoral work at the United States Military Academy at West Point. He is also an alumni member of Leadership Dallas.

With a great passion and commitment to serving the community, Dr. Cothrum spends his spare time supporting numerous non-profit organizations. He plays an active role through his involvement as a member of The McWhiney Foundation and City Hospital at White Rock, and is a board member of the Highland Park Education Foundation. He is also a trustee at Schreiner University and serves on the City of University Park's Public Works Advisory Committee.

PP Richard Stanford called the meeting to order. PP Fred Brown gave the invocation noting that VP Nolan Duck's father-in-law had passed away. Please keep this family in your prayers. PP Richard asked for introduction of guests. Among our guests today was PDG Larry Webb, who manages the District's grant program. Mark Kashar announced our Marketplace Advertiser for this week, PP Happy Franklin and Navihation Financial Group.

PP **Richard** called Scott Denney, the Manager of Maggiano's to the podium. PP **Richard** thanked Scott for all he has done for RCPC, and also remarked that Scott has Rotarians in his family. PP **Richard** made Scott an honorary member of the club.

Jill Jordan announced that the 4th of July is almost here, and that more volunteers are needed, especially as Standing Marshals and Walking Marshals. She also reminded us that volunteers need to dress the part. Alan Winn modeled the appropriate clothes. Sign up with PP Phillip Bankhead.

PP Karen Farris explained that in the last year Rotary International Foundation made \$27 Million in grants to 478 different projects. That is money that flows back into our communities The amount is determined through a Tollway is nw thirty-three miles long and formula based on how much we contribute to RI. Due to the generosity of the members of this club under Greg Pape's leadership, RCPC usually is awarded one of the largest allocations. It was \$5,413.44 and is a matching grant. The RCPC Foundation also awarded the same amount. The Board approved the recipient of the grant, Equest's Hooves for Heroes. Christine thanked RCPC for the grant going to introduce a \$10 toll tag for those ans daid that the impact is incredible. She said that just being out in nature at Equest helps reduce people's resistance to getting help. The grant will pay for a Spring semester and a Fall semester of ten sessions for men

and women veterans who are referred from the VA. Hospital. The grant does not pay just for yhr counseling, but also for the cost of the horse people, the horses, the facility and all that goes into making it possible to change lives. She then showed a brief video of some of the veterans who had benefited from the program.

PP **Richard** reminded us that dues are overdue. Please pay your dues with a check or through the website. He then oversaw the raffle. It has still not been won!

PP Richard introduced our speaker today, Michael Rey, who spoke on the North Texas Tollway Authority. He exxplaine that the NTTA was created in 1997 and is a subdivision of the state of Texas. It is customer driven; they only build what the region requests. It is not funded through tax dollars. They have used \$9.5 Billion in bonds to build roadways and pay off the bonds through tolls That funding is comparable to six cents for every gallon of gas. By the numbers: there are 2.8 Million transaxtions per day, 14 Million customers per year, 6.5 Million active toll Tags, and a 95 percent customer satisfaction rating. They are not involved with the TexPress lanes, but the toll tag works. They have a five-year capital plan.for the upkeep of the roads. They are widening the Dallas North Tollway in Frisco. The Dallas North goes through five cities. They are widening roads in five cities which are experiencing growth. They monitor the roadways for safety and zero in on trouble spots. Tollways need constant maintenance. An ice storm requires a lot of man hours to be out on the roadways spreading materiams on the roads There are \$20 and \$40 toll tags. They are who don't use the tollways often. You can get them to represent your favorite team or school. Toll tags can be used in some other states. The more you use a toll tag, you get Toll Perks, gift cards and other benefits.
