



### Creating Hope for the Homeless with a Foot Care Clinic at our Collaborative Partner, the Austin Street Center

Started in September, 2022, by Holly Hollenbeck, the Foot Care Cllinic for the Homeless continued this year. We hope to continue and expand the program in the future.

With the help of students from the UT-Arlington School of Nursing and the Baylor School of nursing, as well as Rotary volunteers over 130 of the most vulnerable homeless had their feet washed, and received foot care and basic foot health checks. Each person received a new pair of shoes and socks and foot care packages.
