Program: "2023 Parade Grand Marshal," interviewed by Jeff Brady



Jill Jordan introduced our honoree, the 2023 Grand Marshal, Jan Langbein, CEO of the Genesis Women's Shelter. She was inter-

viewed by **Jeff Brady**, She began
by remarking how
many people she
knew. She also
talked about how



much she appreciated the Food Bank. She said so many women who come to the shelter are hungry. Jeff said that he and Jam had known each other for a long time. He noted that Jan was known for her money raising luncheons with celebrity guests, including former President Bush. She related a funny moment when she was interviewing him, Jeff thanked Jan for her vocal leadership and powerful advocacy for women. She has been a true asset to many other agencies as well as a leader in the community and the state, RCPC is very happy to have her as our Grand Marshal. Jeff asked why she had agreed to be GM She said that when Cleve had asked, he had said that it would help raise awareness for Genesis Women's Shelter. She said that many people think that abuse does not happen in their neighborhoods, but it does. She said she knows that there are women in the Park Cities who are afraid in their own homes and whose children cry themselves to sleep at night. Jeff asked how she got involved in this cause. Jan said that when she was in Junior League she saw a magazine that said that one in three women would know domestic violence in an ongoing basis. It is the leading cause of injury to women. So when she picked the agency at which she wanted to volunteer for Junior League, she chose Genesis. She said she had never heard of it, but started as a volunteer. Later they decided they needed a new leader, and she applied and was hired. She said she had no experience in business, but she hired people to help, and she looked to see what the women and children who came there needed and began to add those services. Over time a

In an effort to serve the homeless in our community, we decided to volunteer with Streetside Showers. This remarkable organization provides hot showers, hygiene, and clothing to the homeless and those in need.

Every day, they host free showers using their portable showers and bathrooms at a single location, while on Saturdays they serve two locations that they rotate daily. Additionally, they meet at the same locations on the same day of the week every week. We volunteered at their Plano location as shower valets on Saturday, May 6th.


