Jan Edgar Langbein 2023 Parade Grand Marshal

For more than 32 years, Jan Edgar Langbein has been an activist in efforts to end violence against women. Currently, as CEO of Genesis Women's Shelter & Support, Ms. Langbein oversees Genesis' internal and external operations as well as funding and community education.

Recognized as a National Expert on the dynamics and effects of domestic violence, Ms. Langbein conducts training, keynote, and workshop programs for numerous local, state, and national conferences, social and civic organizations, and corporations. Ms. Langbein provides expert testimony in court cases and trains law

enforcement and prosecutorial professionals to enhance their efforts to end violence against women. In partnership with the Dallas Police Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Ms. Langbein co-founded the annual International Conference on Crimes Against Women with advanced practices of investigation and prosecution bringing together law enforcement, advocates, prosecutors, and forensic health professionals.

Under Ms. Langbein's leadership, Genesis has grown from a seven-room emergency shelter to a full-service response for victims of domestic violence. Genesis Women's *(cont. on pg. 3)*



President **Jeff McNaughton** called the meeting to order. PP **Richard Stanford** read from a letter written by his uncle during World War II. He wrote about his life and his crew and how much they were looking forward to coming home. He was killed the next day in a bombing run. He reminded us that there were 400,000 war deaths in World War II, over 50,000 in Korea, almost 60,000 in Viet Nam, and almost 10,000 in the Middle East wars. They all left behind families. That is the human side of service.

PP **Paul Pirok** gave the invocation, noting that **Leroy Howard** had had a hip replacement and is in rehab. Then he led the singing of "The National Anthem."

President **Jeff** asked for "Happy Bucks." All the proceeds are going to the North Texas Food Bank, the Parade recipient. Don't forget to contribute using the QR code. PP **Richard Stafford** remarked that there are three World War II veterans who are members of Highland Park Methodist Church, including **C. C. Collie** and **Brad Bradley**; all of them are over one hundred years old. Then, President **Jeff** introduced our visitors and guests.

Tiffany Richmond introduced our Marketplace Advertiser for the week, **Kyle Marmillion** and **Marsh & McLennan**.

PP **Happy Franklin** introduced our return-ing member, **Paul McFarland** and his wife **Dawn McFarland**, who is a new member. They are both with The Salvation Army.

John Whaley introduced two Hill-crest H.S. students, **Nyasha Griffin**, Inter-act Presi-dent, and **Carolina Windham**, Inter-act VP. Both will be receiving \$2,000 scholarships, funded by the RCPC Foundation.

Evan Altemus introduced our speaker today, **Cody Bandaris** with **Carry the Load**. **Evan** remarked that when he found out that our

scheduled speaker was in the hos-pital, it was in true veteran fashion that he easily found someone to help out and speak today, **Cody Bandaris** is an am-bassador for **Carry the Load**. **Carry the Load** was founded in 2011.by Navy SEAL, **Clint Bruce**, who wanted to return the true meaning of Memorial Day to the holiday. He decided to put on a rucksack with a pound in it for each of his friends who had died and walk around **White Rock Lake**. During his walk, he was stopped by an older veteran, who asked him who he was carrying. This gave him the idea to found an organization with another veteran . There first goal was just to raise awareness. Since 1911, they have raised \$38,058,334 and have had over 234,377 participants. Ninety-three percent of the money raised has gone to veterans programs, Their mission is to connect Americans with meaningful ways to remember the sacrifices of the military, veterans, first responders and their families. It has grown to include awareness, continuum of care, and education. The walk has grown to five relays that make their way to Dallas, from Minneap-olis, West Point, Des Moines, Omaha, and Chi-cago. The walkers carry flags, and people stop them or come out to greet them or to join them as they walk. Their corporate sponsors pay for putting on the relays, so all of the money con-tributed goes to their continuum of care. This grew from people asking what they could do. Once people started contributing, the organi-zation set up a non-profit board to vet non-profits and contribute to those who are helping to heal the physical, mental and spiritual wounds of veterans, first responders, and their families. Their third program, the education program, is called **Carry The Flag**. It is an out-of-the-box, free curriculum emphasizing patriot-ism for groups or after school programs.

Shelter & Support provides a continuum of care which includes ex-panded shelter services, transitional housing, day care, an on-site school, access to civil legal representation, jobs readiness programming, ESL education, advocacy, and counseling at their residential and nonresidential facilities. Genesis is unique as one of the few victim services programs in the country that accomplishes sustainability without government funding. Since its inception, Genesis has not only developed services of excellence but also innovative programs and funding sources. The organization and success of this model program has been shared statewide to other NGOs.

In 2009, Ms. Langbein concluded a Presidential Appointment as Senior Policy Advisor to the Director of the United States Dept. of Justice Office on Violence Against Women (OVW). As Senior Policy Advisor, Ms. Langbein served as chief strategist of OVW. On behalf of the Director, she guided and evalu-

ated program and administrative processes and worked to implement standards and protocols for internal and external operations. She supported ongoing efforts within OVW for policy issues regarding the implementation of the Violence Against Women Act.

Her extensive professional affiliations include board, advisory, and committee positions with the Texas Council on Family Violence, Family Violence Prevention Council, Dallas County Family Violence Task Force, Family Violence Coalition, Dallas Mayor's Task Force on Domestic Violence, Greater Dallas Injury Prevention Center, and the North Texas Food Bank. She is the recipient of numerous awards for her leadership and community service... (See more in the eBulletin)
