## Scott Murray Sports Champions Share Kindness, Civility, Respect

From US presidents to U.S. Opens the World Series to the World Cup, the Olympic Games to 35 straight Super Bowls, Scott Murray has covered them all. He spent three decades with NBC television as a multi-E Emmy Award-winning television sports anchor and broadcast journalist. Scott's been named Sportscaster of the Year 17 times

by multiple news organizations. He's also been recognized as a Living Legend of Journalism by the Press Club of Dallas and is a recipient of the prestigious Silver Circle Lifetime Achievement Award from the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences.

Scott is presently co-host of a radio/Roku TV program, "Journey Through Sports, Entertainment and Life," that airs weekly on over 800 stations nationwide. He also regularly serves as an emcee/host/moderator for hundreds of corporate conferences and charitable events. In addition, he remains a sought-after key-note speaker and leadership facilitator of his presentation, "Leadership America... Creating Champions of Change Through a Culture of Civility." In addition, he's a published author of two books (*Whatever It Takes: Life Lessons Learned through Sports Legends* and *Bring Out The Best*) and is about to publish his third.

Scott is most proud to have his Scott Murray Scholarship Foundation provide financial

assistance to individuals from the State of Texas who have the desire to further their education but lack the necessary financial resources. The Foundation has presented 19 scholarships in the last two years.

In addition, Scott is most honored to have four awards that bear his name be presented annually:

- The Scott Murray Scholarship for Sports Broadcasting is presented each year by The Lone Star Emmy Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences to four college bound students pursuing a career in Television Sports Broadcasting.
- Scott is also proud to annually present The Scott Murray Scholarship for Film & Media Arts in partnership with The Dallas International Film Festival.
- The Scott Murray Community Service "Difference Maker" Award is presented each year in partnership with the National Football Foundation Gridiron Club of Dallas to a worthy college-bound graduating high school scholar/athlete who has made a philanthropic impact on his community.
- The Scott Murray Excellence in Media Award is annually presented to a worthy media recipient by the Arlington Chamber of Commerce.

On the corporate front, Scott is Chairman/CEO of Murray Media, an Emmy Award-winning video/HD television production and A/V event media company, which he founded with his son. They both were honored to travel to Normandy on the 70th Anniversary of D-Day with two-dozen WWII Veterans and each received an Emmy Award for the documentary they created and produced.

Scott stays active as a volunteer, serving on the board/advisory boards of countless children's, civic, charitable, and non-profit
