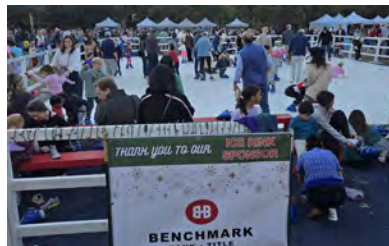

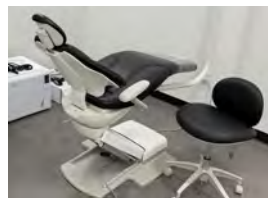

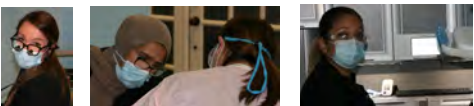

Foot Care Clinic for the Homeless at our Collaborative Partner, the Austin Street Center



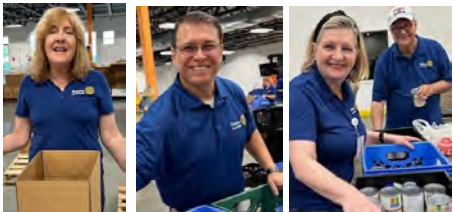

May 3, 2025 = 11,003 meals



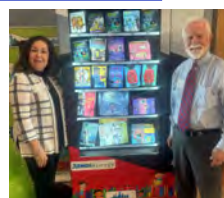
Fostering Leadership
