Living in Australia, you think a lot about water. When you travel to the nation's vast interior, the Outback, you can't help but wonder how such an arid climate has supported life for millennia. There, each sip of water feels precious.

Each sip seems to get more precious by the day as climate change continues to impact water supply everywhere. Where Juliet and I live, on the temperate coast not far from Melbourne, I remember times not long ago when water supplies were so low that severe usage restrictions were put into place. We now live on rainwater that falls onto our roof and is collected in a tank. In many parts of the world, people don't have that luxury.

Water is essential for life no matter where we live. Yet many of us take it for granted. Think of all the times today you turned on the tap. About one in four in the world have quite a different experience when they do — (continued on pg 3)



Richard Stanford introduced our speaker today, RCPC member Paul Hoffmann, Executive Director of Agape Clinic. He has been the Exec-

utive Durector for about a year, but was on the Board for five years. Before he came to Agape, his work has been to take quality health care



through clinics to those who cannot afford it. He said he was delighted to be a part of Rotary and it's service oriented approach. He was asked, "Why does everyone who is diagnosed die?" There are millions in Texas who are underserved or who have no medical care. Agape Clinic has been providing quality mental health care since 1983. Dr. Barbara Baxter started the clinic in a closet at Grace United Methodist Church They will be having a forty-year Anniversary Celebration at the Arboretum in April. He said he is honored to be at Agape: he feels like his life has been for this. Dr. Baxter has created a legacy. She has leveraged partner-ships with LabCorp, Americares, Sams, Baylor and the City of Dallas, among others. LabCorp provides millions of dollars in lab work. In 2015 a building across the street became available, and they renovated it so that it now has thirteen exam rooms and seven rooms for dental care. They are open six days a week. On Sunday afternoon they have a refugee clinic, manned by the graduate school of social work. They had an important strategic planning meeting in October, 2021, and identified three priorities: diversification of funding leading to sustainability, to expand to include more services for women and children. and improving the facility by improving th phone system, increasing the number of computers, and remodeling the second floor. They had to get a new roof; Crystal Charity was very helpful with that. They want to increase services for families, and they need to increase their paid staff. The clinic sees mire females than males. Eighty-one percent of their clients are Hispanic. They hope to expand service for children aged 0 to 17, and have started working with Dallas ISD for Early Childhood.


