### **Rotary Alum Turns Trash to Treasure**

Binish Desai, a 2009-10 Rotary Youth Exchange Student hosted by the Rotary Club of Waukegan IL, founded his own company to create building materials such as bricks from Industrial Waste. The company has converted 600 plus tons of waste into more than forty products.

Desai has been named by Forbes Asia as one of their 30 Under 30 social entrepreneurs.



In 2005, he created his first brick using industrial paper waste and chewing gum. Similar bricks of recycled materials would go to make thousands of stand-alone toilets for rural communities by 2015.

The company he founded, Eco Eclectic Technologies, continues to research and invent new products in pursuit of a clean India. He says "Nothing is useless in this world. What might be a waste to you is someone else's assets." Read more: <https://blog.rotary.org/2018/04/19>

members at meetings! She also announced upcoming events: Race Day at Lone Star Park on May 6, North TX Food Bank Packing Day on May 12, RoughRiders game on May 29, and the Transform Dallas work day which was cancelled earlier, now on June 9.

**Dan Drabinski** introduced our speaker today, **Kelby Woodard**, President of Cristo Rey, Dallas.

**Dan** said there are thirty-two Cristo Reys around the country; they are college preparatory schools for kids who may be the first in their families to attend college. Mayor Mike Rawlings is the person who brought a Cristo Rey to Dallas. Kel-



by said he is proud to be the founding president of Cristo Rey, Dallas. Cristo Rey was founded in Chicago by the Jesuits. However, the families were unable to pay the tuition of a private school. The Jesuits came up with the idea of a work-study program. Now twenty-two years later, sixty-five percent of the operation of the school is funded by the work program. Graduates of Cristo Rey, Dallas are graduating from four-year colleges at the rate of seventy percent, compared to sixteen percent for graduates of Dallas ISD. The work-study program helps the students build the determination, self-confidence and pride to get through the tough times at college. They learn work skills so that when they go off to college, they can get better jobs. The number one problem for first generation college-goers is that they are a financial burden on the families. If they can be financially independent, they have a greater chance of graduating. Eighty percent of their students come from public schools. This is the only private high school in the area. Their curriculum prepares the students to succeed at college. The students work at one hundred and seven companies in Dallas with thirty-five new partners next year.

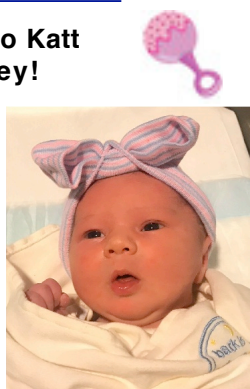
