**Shawn Foster** introduced our speaker to-day, **Bob Tiede**. He began by saying that for much of his career he believed that a leader told people what to do. He changed in 2006 Dale Carnegie said "an effective leader will ask questions instead of giving direct orders. Leading requires both questions and directions. When listening to lengthy directions, a person's mind wanders. Questions focus your attention and you start to think about the answer. If the person with the best answer is asked to implement it, they will work harder. Leaders who lead with questions are ten times more effective than those who just give directions. When you ask questions, you might hear ideas you hadn't thought about. If you get everybody involved, you get even better ideas. When you ask questions, follow up by asking additional questions, Usually a person's first answer is "safe." It takes several questions before the person feels more comfortable and shares their best ideas. People feel valued when a leader asks them for their opinions. Keep questions simple; you don't need to ask complicated questions. If you ask a question which requires the person to think, give them time to respond. Otherwise, they are unlikely to think you wanted their answer. He quoted Henry David Thoreau who said, "The greatest compliment that was ever paid me was when one asked me what I thought and attended to my answer."

## ROTARY INTERNATIONAL

**Preventing drownings is goal of new Rotary club** *excerpted from Rotary Voices by Eve Fraser, charter president of the Rotary Club of Global Water Safety & Drowning Prevention*

In April 2021, the United Nations declared drowning to be the number-one cause of preventable deaths around the world. Africa and Asia were the most affected regions. I had observed swimming teachers delivering lessons to communities in need, struggling with the sheer volume of people who needed to learn to swim and the funding to deliver those programs. I imagined a club where members with the knowledge, skills, and experience worked together to train swimming teachers and help communities deliver sustainable programs.

Last year on UN World Drowning Prevention Day, we chartered a cause-based Rotary club with a group of passionate aquatic educators and industry leaders who were committed to advancing access to quality swimming lessons. Our goal is to ensure that every child can swim before they finish primary school to create generational change.

### HE WHO LAUGHS LASTS

My friend, what's wrong with you? I'm worried, my son has told me that when he grows up he wants to be a skydiver. The one who always leaves his backpack at school? Yes, that's the one!

Our club is truly global, as we meet in 17 countries and represent multiple cultures and diverse backgrounds.
