

# **Gina Norris**The Great 2023 State Fair of Texas

Gina Norris has spent her career working with industrial and real estate-based businesses as an executive in banking and private equity. She serves on the boards of Encore Wire Corporation (NASDAQ: WIRE), Texas Security Bankshares and the State Fair of Texas where from 2019 to 2022, she served as the first chairwoman of the board since its founding in 1886.

Born and raised in the rural Midwest, Gina has volunteered at the State Fair of Texas since 2003 – making her parents and 4-H leaders most proud. She has served as co-chair of the Youth Livestock Auction Committee, and has been a board member since 2009 including as chairwoman of the Finance / Audit Committee.

Since 2013, Gina has worked as SVP/Partner Relations at

Matthews Southwest, a private real estate development company with offices in the U.S., Canada, and the UAE. She started her career with 18 years in banking at First Chicago and Bank One (predecessors of JP Morgan Chase), followed by 10 years at Crow Holdings where she managed a portfolio of investments in operating businesses in the U.S. and EU.

A graduate of Western Illinois University and the McCombs School of Business at The University of Texas at Austin, Gina earned the designation as a Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA) in 2000. Program: "Artificial Intelligence Tools for Business"

President **Jeff Sheehan** called the meeting to order on another hot August afternoon. **William Taylor** gave the invocation and then led the Pledge of Allegiance and "The Star Spangled Banner." President **Jeff** asked for Happy Bucks. He then introduced our visitors and guests, including many colleagues of **Mark Neace** and SyncLab Media, some of whom have spoken to the club, and also a Rotarian who will be joining. RCPC.

**Eric Harrison** introduced our Market Place Advertiser of the Week, **Kathy Wall** and her State Farm Insurance agency. She brought a video to introduce her team and services.

President **Jeff** awarded Paul Hoffman his permanent RCPC Badge, **Eric Harrison** announced the September 30 Foot Care Event. The sign-up pages are now online. Volunteers are needed before and during the event

The raffle total has reached \$1998. **Shawn Foster** won a chance to pick a card, but did not win the raffle.

Mark Neace introduced our speaker today, Larry Roberts. He started by saying that he never thought that AI would bring him to this type of stage, but it was cool to be here. He brought a video which he says addressed some of the concerns that he has heard on a consistent basis. What is Al going to do for my career? How is it going to impact me? Is it going to take my job? The video used an Al generated avatar of Larry to ask these points. He said he used an AI tool to clone his voice for the video and an AI tool to create a younger version of himself. He combined it with a few other AI tools to create the video and did so in about fifteen or twenty minutes. There are a variety of tools that can help streamline the content we are creating, for the marketing campaigns we want to generate for our businesses. One tool is particularly useful, called Chat GPT. He founded Red Hat Media in 2017 to focus on using podcasts in business. He said Artificial Intelligence is anything where we are leveraging machines to act like

human beings, where we are using calculations and algorhithms to get the machines to act like us. That was the goal. One of the subsets of AI is machine learning where the machines them-selves continue to evolve and to learn as tey run the algorhithms. At the Machine Learning level we still have to train them, and to feed them data. We have to change those algorhithms. Humans have to continue to help them evolve. If you go one step learning, it takes you into Deep Learning, another subset of Al. This is where the machines learn on their own. People confuse all Al with this type of Al. This type of Al is referred to as Artificial General Intelligence. Today we are going to be talking about generative Al which allows us to generate a variety of content, whether it is written or visual. The term AI originated in 1956. Since then we have gon through three eras of Al pre-deep learning up until about 2010, deep learning up until 2015, and currently, large scale. Open AI was founded in 2015 by Elon Musk, and everything changed. In November, 2022, Open Al released a tool that made Al accessible to the public for free through a tool called ChatGPT. Now we can use this AI for free to do some really amazing things which would have cost thousands of dollars. It totally changed the way he is creating podcasts. Podcasts are content so he needed video, audio, and written transcripts, but now he has all of this creativity with ChatGPT. ChatGPT has been trained on a massive amount of data and uses a transformer to generate responses. It can turn long articles into key points. It is good for writing, for brainstorming, for reformatting data and for coding in various languages. It is not Al that is going to take your job; it is the people who know how to use the AI tools who will take the jobs. Chat GPT is only about nine months old, but it is critically important that we all understand that we need to be using these tools. You still can't rely on it totally, and you have to do due diligence. There is concern that students will use it, but it cannot teach critical thinking.






