## Mike Rosa **Dallas Regional Chamber**

Mike is Senior Vice President of the Dallas Regional Chamber's economic development program, a position he has held for 20 years.

Mike leads the economic development staff and critical partnering with regional communities and allies, the State of Texas, the Chamber's members, and of course companies and corporate elopment Council (TEDC), the 800-member statewide organizalocation advisors.

In his current role, Mike and his team have supported numerous corporate moves to the Dallas region, including Fortune 500 headquarters relocations and other significant headquarters, office, and industrial projects.

For two years prior to joining the Dallas Regional Chamber, Mike was a Senior Vice President with the Buxton Company, a Fort Worth-basd consulting firm.

For 14 years, beginning in 1988, Mike was with the Fort Worth Mississippi. Chamber of Commerce, initially as director of research and then

becoming Senior Vice President of Economic Development.

Mike holds a Master of Science degree in economic development from the University of Southern Mississippi and a Bachelor of Science degree in regional planning, also from Southern Miss.

In 2015, he served as chairman of the Texas Economic Devtion for economic developers.

He also provides leadership to the DFW Marketing Team, the association of economic development professionals representing Dallas-Fort Worth area cities.

Mike is currently one of 9 appointees to the State of Texas incentives oversight committee that serves the Texas legislature. Though in Texas most of his life, Mike is a Florida native (Dunedin) and also lived in New Orleans and in Pearl River County,

and can be paid with the GoPass Card or with the App. There is a separate program for handicapped riders, which is discounted. It is similar; it is an on call service.

DART's new project is the Silver Line which is a twenty-six mile line covering seven cities and ten rain stations. It starts in Plano and goes to DFW Airport, Terminals A and B. It has luggage racks, wi-fi and bike racks. It will be complete in 2025. The UT-Dallas station is eighty-percent completed. DART worked with the university on the station. Five of seven pedestrian bridges have been completed or are ninety percent complete. Thirty of sixty-one betterment walls have been completed. Right now, the operating plan is 6:00 am to midnight. If there is enough demand to extend that time, the Board will consider changes. The trains run every thirty minutes during peak times and every hour in other weekday service hours. They adjust the train schedules for big events, such as the State Fair. There will be more information about the Silver Line when it is closer to opening.

DART did a comprehensive study which received over ten thousand survey responses. Some of the concerns were security abd being on time. They are increasing their Fare Enforcement Officers. They are not police officers, but they are security. They check tickets, and they also make sure there is no illegal activity on the trains. They have also increased their crews who clean the buses. DART has not looked at their fare structure since before COVID. They have several passes which have been confusing. They are proposing to change to a Day Pass or a Monthly Pass. They will remove the Annual Pass. Paratransit for the disabled will stav the same. There will be a new discounted fare program for vet-erans. They are seeing an in-


