

Our Chair of the Day, Richard Stanford, was well acquainted with our Speaker of the Day, Brad Schwall. He not only introduced him but endorsed him after many years as a colleagues and friends.

A\\s Pesident & CEO of The Center for Integrative Counseling and Psychogy, Brad is Park Cities based and can be found through tthecentercounseling.org. Considering his audience and our members' need to converse

with many, he began with a very cogent point for holding conversations. He expressed the importance of listening. .We must listen first, for a good quality conversation. We need to pay attention to each other. Be present in the conversation. Brad also introduced concepts of EI, emotional Intelligence. He recommended we listen for "who tthey are" as we don't know their experience. Brad also talked about counseling and recommended iit for everyone. It is like going to the doctor. It is "growth promoting"; accessing a third party for expertise to help you go through life's challenges.Brad shared a handout, Caring Conversations He walked us through the outline/steps of a caring conversation. It begins with Listening and moves through Reflecting, Validation, Problem-Solving. His examples are for helping children think.

As I listened, I couldn't he;p but think that a "listening model" is also a tool for our leadership toolbox.

The creation of Rotary's PolioPlus prooram in 1985 sealed a promise: to eradicate polio from the world so no child will ever have to fear being paralyzed by the disease. It is an audacious goal. As International PolioPlus Committee Chair Mike McGovern said recently, "Polio is our moonshot." Thanks tto the tenacity of Rotary members and our partners in the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, we are in the last, though most difficult mile of this

With polio cases down 99.9% since 1988 and wild polio cornered to just two countries, Pakistan and Afghanistan, it would be easy to say, "Polio eradication is just too hard and taking too long. This is good enough." It's true that we are facing extraordinary challenges right now with rising geopolitical tensions, humanitarian


