Frederick P. Cerise, MD, MPH Parkland Hospital

Frederick P. Cerise, MD, MPH, was named President and Chief Executive Officer in March 2014. He is the man "set to take on one million Dallas patients." "I just got a sense that there was great general support for the work that's done at Parkland. People are proud of it, and they want it to continue," Cerise said during a Dallas Morning News interview.

Prior to joining Parkland, Dr. Cerise served as Associate Dean for Clinical Affairs at the Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center. New Orleans School of Medicine. From 2007 to 2012, he was Vice President for Health Affairs School of Public Health. He is a member of the Kaiser and Medical Education of the Louisiana State University System. From 2004 to 2007, Dr. Cerise was Secretary of the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals. He began his career at the Earl K. Long Medical Center, Baton

Rouge, La. Between 1991 and 2004, he advanced from the role of Assistant Program Director and Clinical Faculty member to Medical Director and ultimately served as Chief Executive Officer.

Dr. Cerise holds a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Notre Dame and earned his Medical Degree at Louisiana State University in New Orleans. He completed a residency in Internal Medicine at the University of Alabama in Birmingham. In 2011, he earned a Master of Public Health degree from Harvard University Commission on Medicaid and the Uninsured and has served on the Louisiana Federal Health Care Reform Steering Committee and the Louisiana Health Care Quality Forum, among others.

Shelterbox Update: Ecuador Earthquake

The ShelterBox Response Team (SRT) is traveling to Ecuador to carry out assessments following the catastrophic 7.8 magnitude earthquake near the northern town of Muisne.

The Ecuadorian government has formally requested international aid and the shelter cluster has been activated. A Response Team, led by Jon Berg (UK) and

Kara Lapso (US), is now traveling to Ecuador to assess the level of destruction and what type of emergency shelter is needed. Shelter-Box has pre-positioned aid in nearby Colom-

> bia, as well as in Panama and Bolivia, which can be guickly transported into the country if a deployment is activated. www.ShelterBoxUSA.org.
