David E. Daniel, PhD, President – UTD An Update on Why DFW Needs UT Dallas to Become a Tier One University

David E. Daniel is the fourth president of The University of Texas at Dallas. He holds bachelors, masters, and PhD degrees in civil engineering from The University of Texas at Austin, where he taught from 1980 to 1996. In 1996, he joined the University of Illinois and later became its Dean of Engineering. His appointment at UT Dallas began in 2005.

Dr. Daniel is a member of the National Academy of Engineering, the nation's most prestigious organization recognizing engineering achievement, was chair of the American Society of Civil Engineers external review panel of the levee failures during Hurricane Katrina, and served as a member of a committee charged with investigating the Deepwater Horizon explosion and oil spill in the Gulf of Mexico.

During Dr. Daniel's presidency, UT Dallas has tripled its research expenditures, completed \$700 million in construction of new buildings and infrastructure, added 40 new degree programs, and successfully completed its first comprehensive fundraising campaign, exceeding a \$200 million goal to reach a total of more than \$270 million. Student enrollment is at more than 23,000 and among freshmen, a record number of National Merit Scholars (4 percent) were enrolled, which is the second highest percentage of any public university in America.



His high school graduating class had fifty-nine kids in it. He said he loves sports, but is disgusted by what some people do in the name of sports. He gave the example of the Little League team who had their



championship taken away because the adults decided to cheat. In 1984 Texas passed "no pass, no play." He remarked that coaches wouldn't let players play who made mistakes five percent of the time, but they are still complaining about the requirement that players make seventy percent in the classroom. He said that everything he is today he owes to what his dad taught him on the baseball field: to play with enthusiasm, that success or failure is judged by what you contribute to the success of your team, to make the people around you better, to play the game by the rules, and that people in authority are entitled to respect. He said he gives people a chance to excel and that it always come back to him. He said that his dad was the strongest and hardest working man he even knew, and that he worked until he was eighty when he was finally retired due to hs age. He was asked about the situation with Dez Bryant and Dean obnoxious jerk. He also marco Murray. He said that he thought the Cowboys would keep both, but if they only kept one, it would be Dez Bryant. He was asked what his opinion was about paying college players. He said that he felt that players should be compensated because they bring in money for the university, but that athletes in all sports might be required to be paid, even though many sports lose money. He closed by quoting Ted Kennedy, "We know that the future will outlive all of us, but we live on in the future we make," and he wants to make the future better for his children and grandchildren.
