## John Peavy The Stock Market: What Really Matters

John W. Peavy, III is Chairman of the Investment Committee of First Private Wealth Management and a director of First Private Bank of Texas. He also is Professor of Professional Practices in Finance at Texas Christian University. He currently serves as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Employees' Retirement Fund of the City of Dallas.

He previously was the Chief Investment Officer of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas where he was responsible for the investment of assets in excess of \$80 billion for more than one million beneficiaries. He also was founder, Chairman and Chief Investment Officer of Founders Trust Company which was acquired by Wells Fargo Bank.

Peavy served on the faculty of Southern Methodist University where he held the Vaughn-Rauscher Chair of Financial Investments and was Chairman of the Department of Finance. He also held the Morris Chair of Finance at the Darden Graduate School at the University of Virginia.

Peavy received a B.B.A. from SMU, an M.B.A. from the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania, and a Ph.D. from the University of Texas at Arlington. He is a Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA), a Chartered Financial Consultant (ChFC), a Chartered Life Underwriter (CLU), and Associate Editor of the *Journal of Investing*.

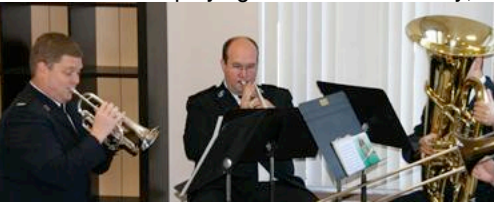

**Orville Salmon** introduced today's program which began with the Salvation Army band members playing a Christmas medley,



"O Joyous Christmas." Bandmaster Jeff Barington then played a lovely cornet solo of "I Wonder As I Wander." **Orville** introduced our speaker today, Major Terry Israel. He remarked on the long association of Rotary and the Salvation Army. RCPC has been having chili at the Salvation Army for almost fifty years. He also thanked **Bob Grossman** who has been preparing the chili for thirty-two years, and **Donnie Berg** for providing the venison. Major Israel reviewed the history of the Salvation Army, which was founded by William Booth in 1865 to help the poor in London's East End. Wm. Booth was a tireless worker for reform. He was instrumental in passing child labor laws. He was concerned for the health of workers who were making matches, but was told that a safer process was too expensive. He then bought a match factory, made the safer matches, and sold them at a loss to put the other factories out of business - the origin of Safety Matches. The Salvation Army came to the U.S. in 1880 and to Dallas in 1892. Across Texas the Salvation Army has provided 1.1 million nights of lodging and 3.5 million meals. He estimated that one in every fifty people has benefited from the services of the Salvation Army.
