# Mary Ellen Weber To Boldly Go ...

Mary Ellen Weber is founder of Stellar Strategies, LLC, which provides consulting services in strategic communications and in strategies for high-stakes operations and ventures. In addition, she is an acclaimed speaker with over 20 years of experience.

Weber serves as a member of the NASA Advisory Council Committee on Technology and Innovation, the board that advises NASA on its technology investment plan and commercialization. She also serves on the Board of Directors for Uplift Education, which operates 20 highperforming charter schools in underserved areas in Texas.

Previously, Weber was vice president for government affairs for nine years at UT Southwestern Medical Center — a \$1.6 billion internationally-renowned research center, hospital complex, and medical school in Dallas — where she focused on strategic communications and analytical

strategies to successfully increase annual appropriations from \$100 million to \$170 million.

Weber also was a NASA Astronaut for ten years, a veteran of two Space Shuttle flights. She flew in 1995 aboard Discovery to launch a communications satellite and again in 2000 aboard Atlantis to construct the Space Station. She also held key positions in space operations, in building businesses from research, and in program oversight, and is the recipient of the NASA Exceptional Service Medal.

Weber received her Ph.D. in physical chemistry from Berkeley, an M.B.A. from SMU, and a B.S. in chemical engineering from Purdue. She is an active skydiver—with nearly 5,000 jumps, thirteen medals at the U.S. National Championships and a world record—and an instrument-rated pilot



President Fred called the Annual Meeting of the Rotary Club of Park Cities to order, and read the slate of nominees for officers and Board members for 2013-14. The slate was elected unanimously.

Cleve Clinton introduced our speaker today, Mark Banta, the President of Klyde Warren Park, and also a member



of the Dallas RC. He explained that the park exemplified the "magic of green space." He explained that the park was first identified in 2004, that the City of Dallas and

the Woodall Rogers Park Foundation negotiated a development agreement and that building started in 2009. The park received \$20 Million from the City of Dallas, \$17 Million from federal stimulus funds, and \$53 Million from private funds. Now that it is open, it is self-sufficient, receiving revenue from events, vending, etc. It is a technological marvel, down to the artificial, engineered soils. It is also a place for people to come and gather, with more programming than is usual in parks. There is a performance pavilion, a Grand Plaza with a restaurant and performance pavilion and fountain. The restaurant will enable 320 people to eat at the same time. The chairs outside were made in France and designed to be easily moved and re-grouped. Other areas of the park include a children's park divided into an area for toddlers and one for older children, a reading and games room where games may be checked out free, a dog park, and Jane's Lane which is an area to go to relax. They have given a lot of attention to security and hope to prevent any problems.


