VP **Eric Heitkamp** introduced our speaker today, PDG Dave McSpadden. PDG Dave remarked that PDG **C.C. Collie** is one of his heroes. PDG Dave said that we are members of the most blessed species on the planet, and that we can change our ways of thinking. We have larger brains for our size than any other animal. He explained

brain plasticity as the ability of the brain to grow and change itself throughout the life span. He described the God-given power of choice as the means to making this the best year of your life. You can decide today that this will begin the best year of your life. Why do people not do the things that they could to change as they want to. He believes that one of the contributing factors is that as we grow older, we lose our child-like wonder. We build our own armor which keeps us from connecting with others. We live in a world controlled by our time-saving devices. PDG Dave told of a speaker at his own Rotary Club who arrived in a motorized wheelchair. He was paralyzed from the neck down, but he was building an entire village in Mexico. He sent out a weekly newsletter to churches and other sponsors using a laser pointer and a computer screen. After he broke his neck, while he was in the hospital, he began to believe that he was alive for a reason. He studied carpentry and electrical skills, and he goes to Mexico every other month to do his mission work. PDG Dave feels that this illustrates the power of making the right choices. If you sit down, you will shut down.
