

## Park Cities 4<sup>th</sup> of July Parade Inclement Weather Policy - 2021

The parade is scheduled to start at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>.

**Rain-** The event will not be cancelled due to light rain. However heavy rain which could cause unsafe conditions for parade participants, volunteers and public servants will cause a postponement or cancellation. If this occurs, the start of the parade will be delayed 30 minutes and re-evaluated. Due to traffic constraints of road closures, the parade cannot be postponed for any significant length of time beyond that. **Lightning** - In the event of lightning, the Parade will be postponed by 30 minutes every time lightning strikes within 6 miles of the event. Please note the parade cannot be postponed significantly past 9:30 a.m. due to traffic constraints of road closures. Please note that each time lightning strikes and thunder is heard within 6 miles of any part of the parade route, the timing of 30 minutes increments must restart.

**Parade Underwriters** - If the Parade must be cancelled, please be aware that there will be no refunds of fees or payments.

**Beneficiary Sponsors** - To those that have made donations to the North Texas Food Bank as the Parade beneficiary, those donations have been accepted by NTFB and cannot be refunded in the event of a parade cancellation.
