




Conference Chair Susan Harris thanked all the team leaders who have been contacted by John Schubert and accepting their roles. And a special thanks to John Schubert for all you


Dr Dumalaon-Canaria has a great interest in participatory design, community engagement, workforce development, and processes that promote diversity, equity, inclusion, and resilience.


