 - She thanked Don Marcoionni for making up the wooden centre table pieces They look fantastic, and you will see them on the night.




- Please wear your lanyards wherever you go to the conference as it is proof of your registration




to meet and greet buyers as required. If you can spare a day a week either Monday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday. Ralph can then draft up a roster to share the duties.




