RICHARD W. HELD

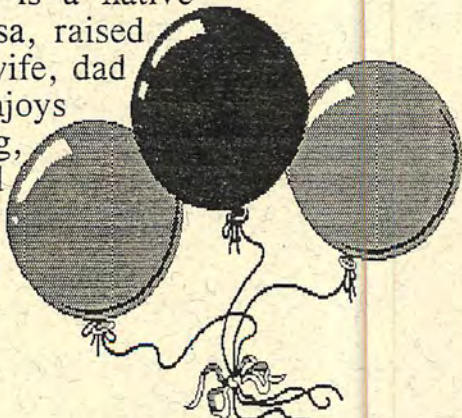

ROAMIN ROTARIANS...

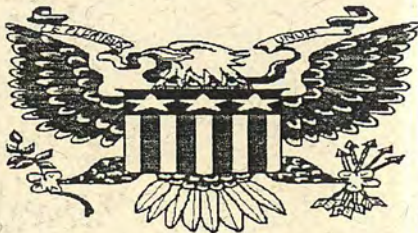
Gary Jensen, got a whopping \$20.00 fine for the FOUR WEEKS he has been playing in the sun! Let's hear it for the tan!

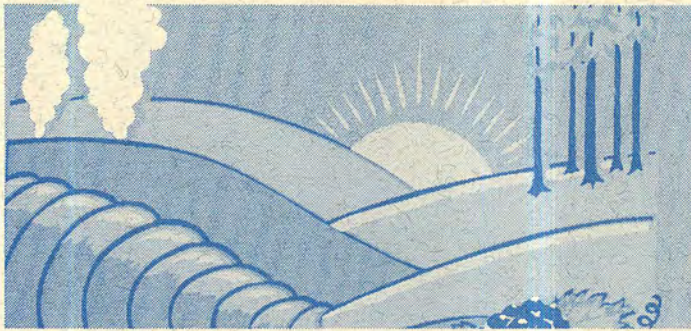

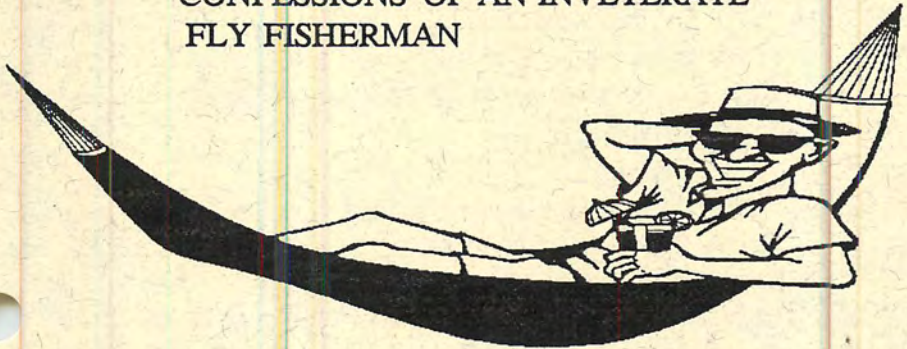

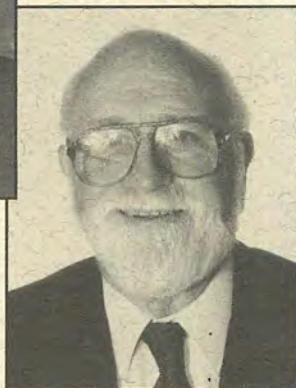

Our Dollars At Work...

The World Community Service project spear headed by *John Jones and Steve Davis* has finally

come to fruition. Santa Rosa Sunrise dedicated \$1,000 towards the Coyhaique, Chile school project. Kagoshima, Japan (our sister club) also contributed \$1,000 and District 5130 matched our funds with an additional \$1,000. The \$3,000 contribution was then matched by



the Rotary Foundation, Matching Grant Program (some of our Paul Harris money at work) which brought the total grant to \$6,000. The \$6,000 will be used in three rural boarding schools for the following items: Wood burning stoves, (the schools are next to a glacier and they don't have any heat at the present time); electric grinders, arc welders, and knitting machines (for teaching vocational skills); and repair of the hygienic facilities. A great example of three different countries and a lot of good people working together to make a difference in some kids lives. Thanks to all of those who helped make this project possible!

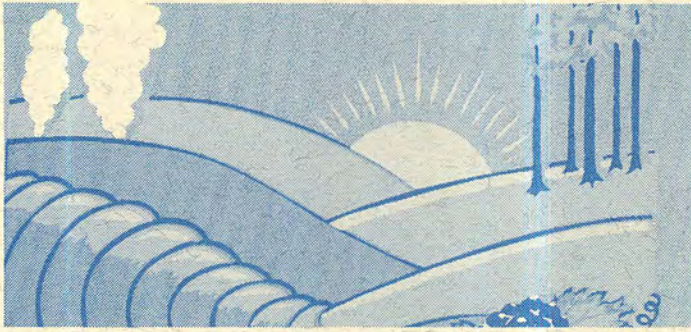

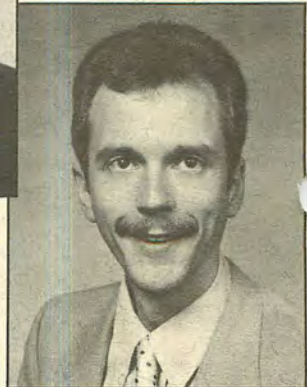

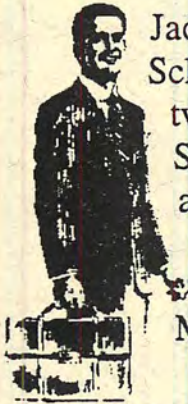
