More news on int'l projects

12 persons have signed up for the Guatemala Eyeglass Project. This number could increase to around 18 when spouses are included. John Jones will be working on finalizing the count in the next two to three weeks. The Rotary budget for the trip is \$2000. The cost per person is estimated at \$750, including meals and some lodging expenses. The sorting of the eyeglass inventory, crucial prep work for this project, will begin in late April—please sign up to help with this work.

Further Interact Update:

On Valentines Day, our club members assisted Rotarians to help deliver flowers for local florists. These efforts were rewarded with a check for \$250 for the Interact treasury. To date, all club officers

have been guests at a Sunrise Rotary Club breakfast meeting. Four students have been honored as Interact Student of the Month. Whenever possible, the parents have attended the ceremony. A Sunrise Rotary Youth Grant program has been established to provide young people with financial assistance toward the pursuit of their goals. This year fifteen \$250 grants have been offered. Attendance at an Interact meeting now counts as an official 'make-up' for Sunrise Rotary and it is a rare meeting when we do not have Rotarian guests. At A recent meeting, Teagan and Triana Parks were surprise guest speakers. Until they graduated, they were charter members and officers in Interact.



They gave an informal talk about how being a member of Interact had a positive impact on their lives. It was very inspirational and nice to hear them back. Peer testimonials work well with students and 'T & T' were well received. Our next major project will be to provide assistance in the running of the 10th Annual S. R. Sunrise Rotary Golf Tournament on May 14th. This fundraiser will generate approximately \$18,000 for local charities and the Elsie Allen Interact Club is proud to be able to be a partner. Interact Club membership is presently at thirty. On March 19 - 21, seven students from Elsie Allen High attended the 1999 Interact Leadership Conference at Alliance Redwoods in Occidental. This set a new participation record for our club. Over two-hundred students from twenty-four of the thirty-five Interact Clubs in our district enjoyed three days of fun, skits, mixers, inspirational speakers and a Saturday night 'swing dance'. Our own President Russ made a SRKSEP presentation during dinner on Friday. What a wonderful way for Merle Hayes to celebrate her birthday weekend! The Rotary Youth Leadership Activity (RYLA) program will be held June 13 -18, 1999. This is a week-long instructional camp for the development of leadership skills. It is open to students who have completed their Junior year in high school and is being held at Westminster Woods, near Occidental.
