Local and visiting U.S. Rotarians regularly provide medical and dental care, treating approximately 200 children per year. The program also supports the educational needs of children including scholarships, vocational training, and English as a Second Language classes. Volunteers have also been active in building shelters for homeless families and have helped to repair and maintain several orphanages and migrant worker camps. Santa Rosa Sunrise has participated this year in the building of "casitas" this year through a WCS grant contribution of \$10,000. **Why should we BRING A FRIEND TO ROTARY!**

In a recent speech at the International Assembly, RI President-nominee **Richard King** addressed this question with 20 answers:

- 1.) **Friendship.** In an increasingly complex world, Rotary provides one of the most basic human needs: the friends and fellowship. It is one of the two reasons why Rotary began in 1905.
- 2.) **Business Development.** The second original reason for Rotary's beginning. Everyone needs to network. Rotary consists of a cross section of every business community. Its members come from all walks of life. Rotarians help one another, and collectively help others.
- 3.) **Personal Growth and Development.** Membership in Rotary continues one's growth and education in human relations and personal development.
- 4.) **Leadership Development.** Rotary is an organization of leaders and successful people. Serving in Rotary positions is like a college education in Leadership: learning how to motivate, influence, and lead leaders.
- 5.) **Citizenship in the Community.** Membership in a Rotary club makes one a better community citizen. The average Rotary club consists of the most active citizens of any community.
- 6.) **Continuing Education.** Each week at Rotary there is a program designed to keep one informed as to what is going on in the community, nation, and world. Different speakers, different topics.
- 7.) **Fun.** Rotary is fun. A lot of fun. Each meeting is fun. The club projects are fun. Social activities are fun. And the service is fun.
- 8.) **The Development of Public Speaking Skills.** Many an individual who joined Rotary was afraid to speak in public. Rotary develops confidence and skill in public communication. And opportunity.
- 9.) **Citizenship in the World.** Every Rotarian wears a pin that says: "Rotary International." And every Rotarian is welcome — even encouraged to attend — at 29,000 clubs in 194 nations and geographical regions. There are few places on the globe which do not have a Rotary club. Instant friends in both one's own community and in the world community.
- 10.) **Assistance when Traveling.** Because there are Rotary clubs everywhere, many a Rotarian who has needed a doctor, lawyer, hotel, dentist, advice, etc., while traveling has found the same quickly through Rotary.
- 11.) **Entertainment.** Every Rotary Club and district has parties and activities, which provide diversion in one's business life. Rotary has conferences, conventions, assemblies and institutes which provide entertainment in addition to Rotary information, education and service.
- 12.) **The Development of Social Skills.** Every week and at various events and functions, Rotary develops one's personality, social and people skills. Rotary is for people who like people, or who want to be.
- 13.) **Family Programs.** Rotary provides one of the worlds largest youth exchange programs; high school and college clubs for future Rotarians; spouse clubs and programs; and a host of activities designed to assist family members in growth an the development of family values.
- 14.) **Vocational Skills.** Every Rotarian is expected to take part in the growth and development of his or her own profession or vocation; to serve on committees and to teach youth about one's job or vocation. Rotary helps to make one a better doctor, lawyer, teacher (or whatever one does for a living) etc.
- 15.) **The Development of Ethics.** Rotarians practice a 4-Way Test, which governs one's ethical standards. Rotarians are expected to be ethical in business and personal relationships.
- 16.) **Cultural Awareness.** Around the world, practically every religion, country, culture, race, creed, political persuasion, language, color and ethnic identity is found in Rotary.

20.) **The Opportunity to Serve.** Rotary is a service club. Its business is mankind; its product is service. Rotarians provide community service — to both the local and international communities. This is the best reason perhaps for becoming a Rotarian: the chance to do something for somebody else. And to sense the self-fulfillment which comes in the process. And the return to one's own life. Rotarians believe in Service Above Self; it is richly rewarding. **"HE PROFITS MOST WHO SERVES BEST."**

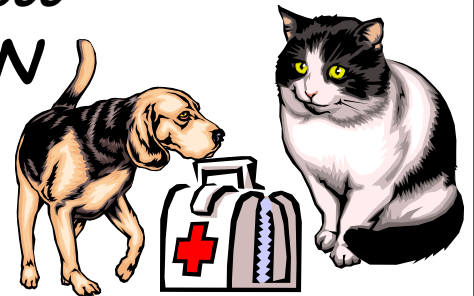

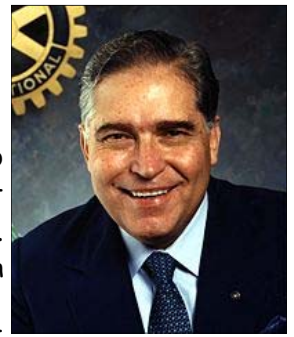

**Past Rotary International President Paulo Costa dies at 70**

On behalf of the RI Board of Directors, RI President Carlo Ravizza announces to the Rotary world the death of a great humanitarian and Rotarian, 1990-91 RI President Paulo V.C. Costa, who died 10 April in São Paulo, Brazil, from an infection following surgery in March.



Born in Santos in 1930, Paulo joined the Rotary Club of Santos in 1956. As president of Rotary International, he pursued his passionate concern for the environment by spearheading Rotary's Preserve Planet Earth program. As a result of his vigorous enthusiasm for preserving the world's ecology, Rotarians have planted millions of trees worldwide and addressed many other pressing environmental issues. During his year as president, he also championed the RI theme Honor Rotary With Faith and Enthusiasm — two characteristics that were hallmarks of Paulo himself.

Paulo served RI as district governor, International Assembly discussion leader, committee member and chairman, United Nations special representative, Foundation trustee chairman, director, vice-president, and president. He received The Rotary Foundation's Distinguished Service Award, Citation for Meritorious Service, and PolioPlus Pioneer Award and was also a Foundation Benefactor.

**Scott Holder is Santa Rosa Sunrise Newest Paul Harris Fellow**

All together fitting on Bring A Friend to Rotary Day, **Scott Holder** was presented his *Paul Harris Fellow* recognition as he became the 82nd confirmed PHF in Santa Rosa Sunrise.

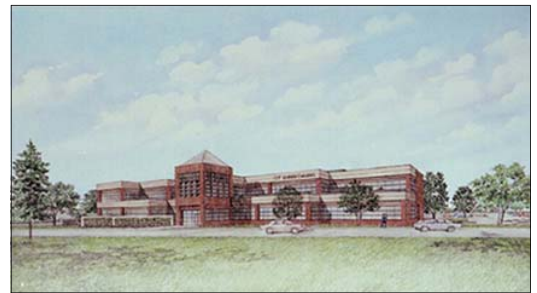

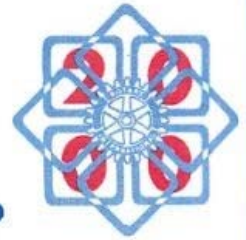

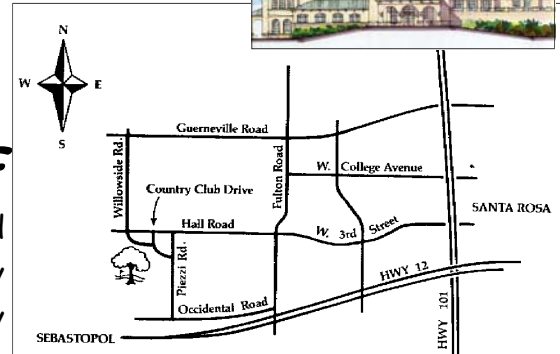
