

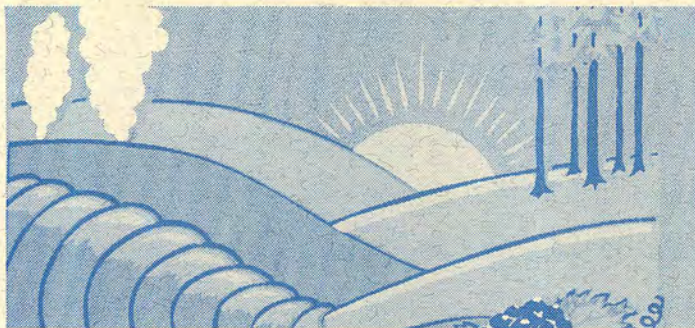

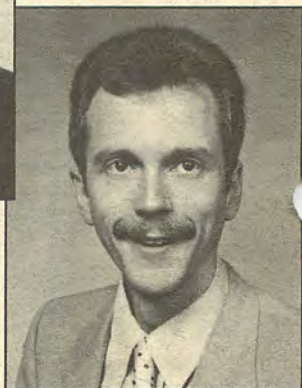

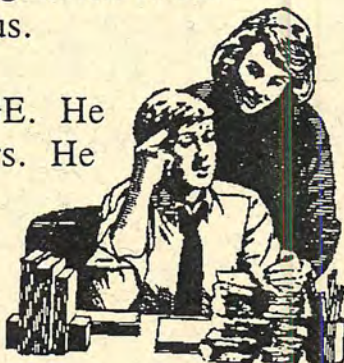

Our new friends from Kagoshima are about to leave, but there is a long history between our two cities. It began in Japan, when the Emperor sent 15 young men to learn the western world's ways. He knew Japan would need those skills in the years to come. One of the fifteen men, Kanaye Nagasawa would come to Santa Rosa, in 1875, and spend many years developing the Fountain Grove Winery. The "Round Barn" is all that remains of the estate. The first wines imported to England from America, came from the Fountain Grove Winery.



A "Rotary Sister Club" relationship developed in 1989, between Santa Rosa Sunrise and Kagoshima-Nishi, Kanaye's home. Friends of Kagoshima, a local organization, and Santa Rosa Sunrise, (by our own charter member- *Dan Lambert*) have developed the program (SRKSEP) which sends students on this short, cultural exchange. Over the past few years, there have been 65 students participate. We can be proud of the difference it has made not only in the students lives but in the lives of all those who have participated.

Please join in this fond "SAYONARA" party at *Archie/Sue Julian's* home. A potluck dinner will begin at 6:00pm.

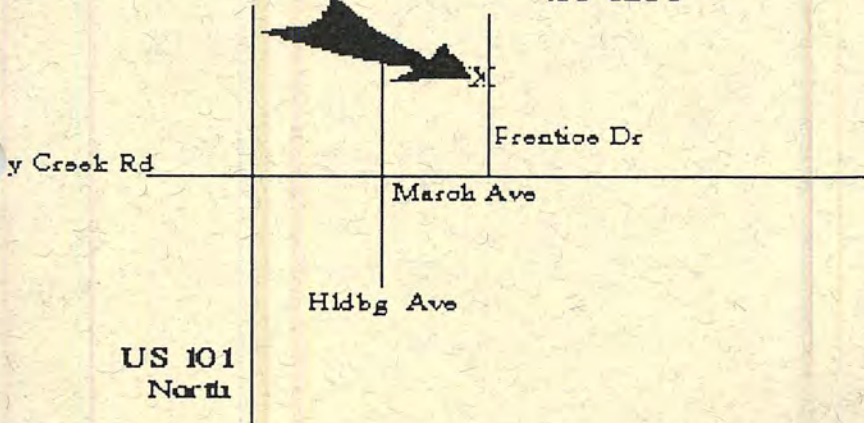

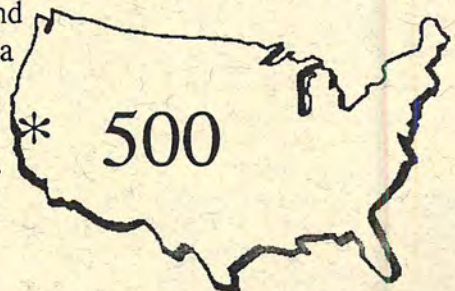
EDMUND H. SMITH, Ph.D. Principal Environmental Scientist

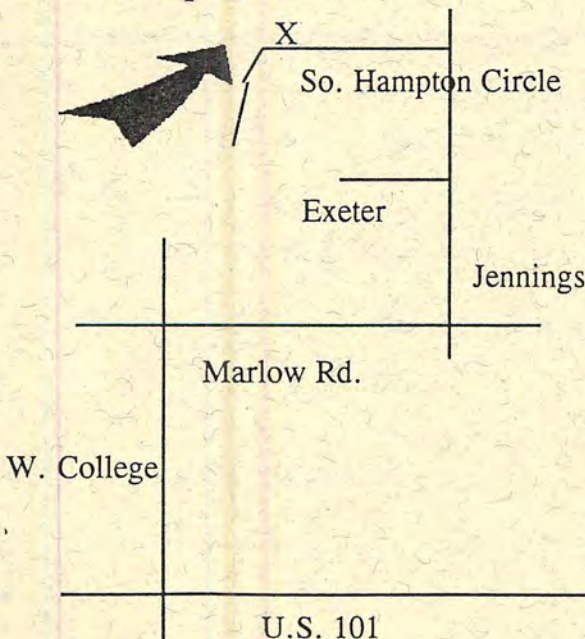
HE'S HERE...

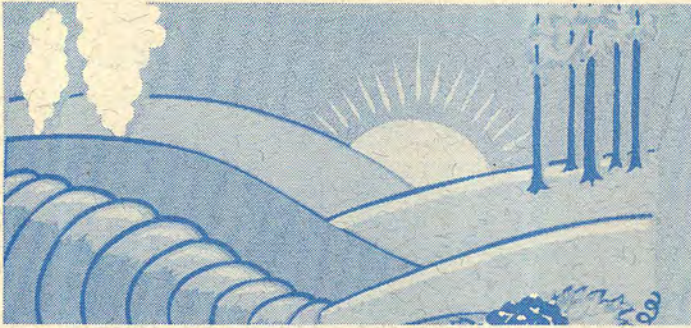

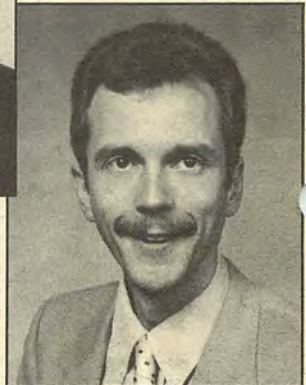

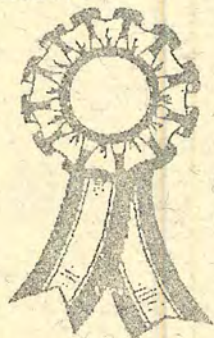
You should remember that you are considering the new member not only for club fellowship, but for membership in a worldwide organization.
