## **UPDATE: The Sunrise Club World Service Project**

Dale Zumfelde was kind enough to bring us all up to date on the status of the club's World Service Project under his guidance and inspiration:

The Project to provide surgical instruments to the University Clinical Hospital Rebro in Zagreb, is nearing completion. When we receive the required letter of support and participation from RI's District Governor's office in Vienna, Austria, we will submit the completed application to the Rotary Foundation for its consideration and approval.

Because of the involvement and generosity of two other local Rotary clubs (the Guerneville & SR East Clubs), the project has grown into one that can do a lot of good from many people in the area of the former Yugoslavia. What started out as an idea with a very limited goal has quickly grown into a project which will send **\$24,531.48** in surgical instruments to people who desperately need assistance in their attempt to resume normal lives after four years of war.

The money to fund this undertaking has come from the following sources:
