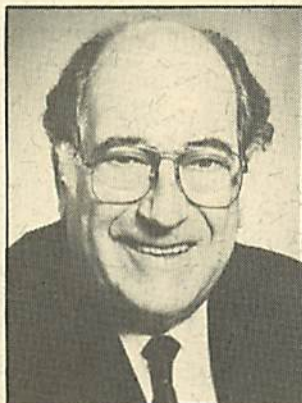

From the July 1993 Rotarian

A short-term investment in polio eradication today will yield great benefits tomorrow at the global level, both in human and financial terms. According to the World Health Organization (WHO), it will cost an estimated U.S. \$1.1 billion over a 10 year period to wipe out polio. However, the effort will be cost-effective by the year 1998, saving governments millions of dollars.

In fact, says WHO, the eradication of polio will pay for itself many times over by eliminating the cost of polio vaccine and rehabilitation. International health officials estimate that potential eradication would result in savings of \$500 million annually by the year 2000 - and \$3 billion per year by 2015.

Since the world's last case of smallpox in 1977, for example, the United States alone has "saved" its total contribution to the global smallpox program once every 26 days.

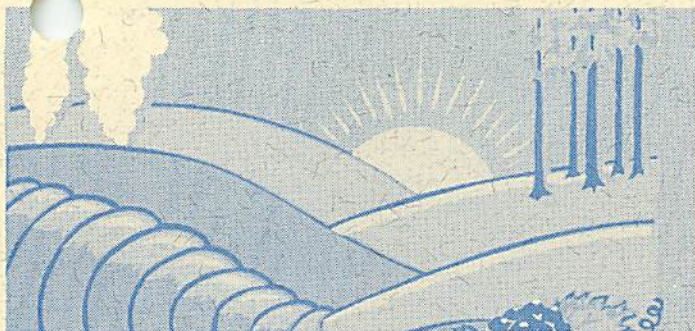
