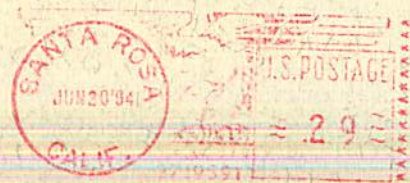

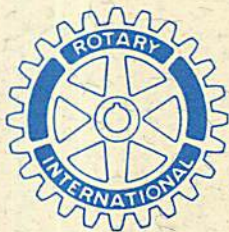

Paul Harris Fellows make a difference. A gift of \$1,000 will fund projects and programs to improve and invigorate the lives of people around the world and enhance international friendship and understanding. Here are examples of what the Rotary Foundation can do with \$1,000:

1. Provide transportation for a member of a Group Study Exchange.
2. Provide 10 shallow tube wells in Bangladesh that will double the rice production and triple the vegetable production of small farms.
3. Buy polio vaccine to protect 5,000 infants against polio for life or provide orthopedic surgery, crutches, braces or wheelchairs and rehabilitative training for seven polio victims in Malawi.
4. Provide a broader spectrum of medical services for 830 people in Mali where hospital and medical services are inadequate for the population.
5. Provide pacemakers for two indigent individuals in the Caribbean.
6. Contribute school supplies for more than 1,200 needy children in Guatemala.
7. Give nutritional training to 127 women in Thailand's poorest region, introducing them to nutritional food and following up on nutritional development for their children.
