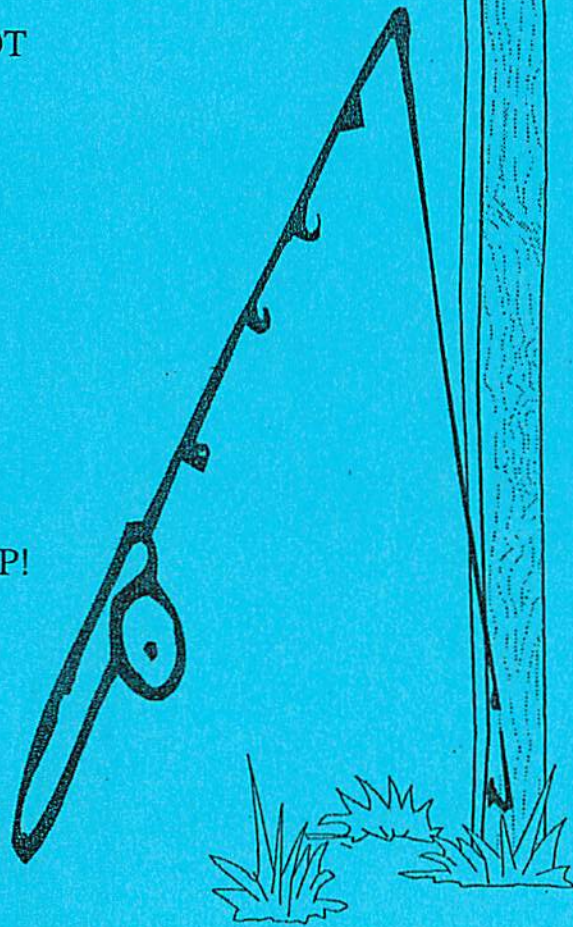
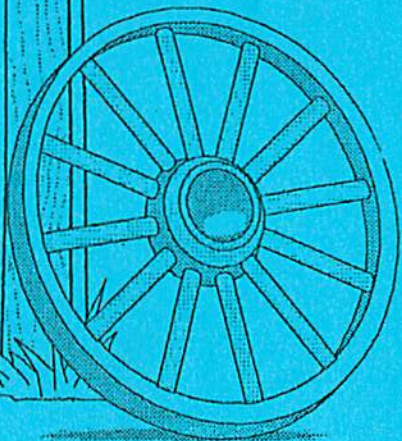
CAMP ROTARY

REMEMBER – PARTY STARTS AT 6:30 P.M. SHARP!



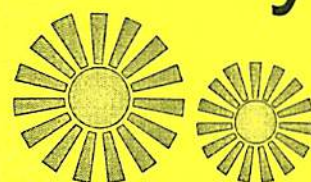
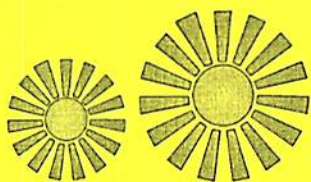

Ed told us of the eye-glass mission to Guatemala and how he and his 13 fellow Rotarians and Rotarians-at-heart worked 11 hour days examining the eyes of 1200 Guatemalans. It truly is inspirational to realize the planning, organization, and effort that is involved in giving the gift of unblurred vision. Each member of this workparty shared a bit of their Guatemala experience. John Jones said they examined 367 folks on their first day and dispensed 700 pairs of glasses during the course of their work week. 80 of those examined were determined to suffer from cataracts which essentially means that they will eventually lose their sight entirely unless they undergo surgery to have the cataracts removed. Fortunately, thanks to Ed Carrette's contacts in Guatemala, these people will be able to have this sight-saving operation. For Steve Amend, going to Guatemala was an opportunity to experience the culture of this region and see the ancient city of Tikal which he had only read about as a student of anthropology in college. But what did he like best? "The hugs," said Steve. Vicky Lockner became known as the "Queen Fitter" because of the great skill she demonstrated in properly fitting folks for their eyeglasses. Vicky, who loves to wear brightly colored clothes, wore a gorgeous and brilliantly colored outfit that she purchased in Guatemala. Dan Lambert was overwhelmed by the beauty of the place, the stunning lake views and ancient Mayan ruins of Tikal. Dan shared with us being humbled by a 78 year old man, who, having no legs, is wheelchair-bound. In addition to this substantial disability, the gentleman has only one eye. "How much

could this person benefit from a pair of glasses?" thought Dan. Well, plenty, apparently. The glasses this fellow received make a meaningful difference in the quality of his life. Keith Taylor and Bob "Roberto" Scott worked in inventory dispensing the eyeglasses. Bob's wife, Kathy helped by fitting people with their eyeglasses. Keith, like Vicky and the others, was attired in a wonderfully bright woven jacket that he acquired during the trip. Keith admitted that, since he's retired, he is not used to getting up early and working long days. Just getting to Rotary on Thursday mornings was a challenge. "That's easy after Guatemala," says Keith. Carmen, Keith's wife, was also along for this adventure. Carmen had one of the toughest jobs as she and Les Shipley had to work in very close quarters in the darkened (and very hot) examination room. Mary Farha, who claims she "failed the fitting department," worked preparing the patients for their examinations by dispensing eyedrops and also explained to those people with good vision that they didn't need glasses. She joked about how easy it was to "get into Dan Lambert's pants." You see, Mary's luggage was lost on the way to Guatemala. Apparently she came to Dan beggin' for britches to wear. Being the gentleman that Dan is, he naturally obliged.
