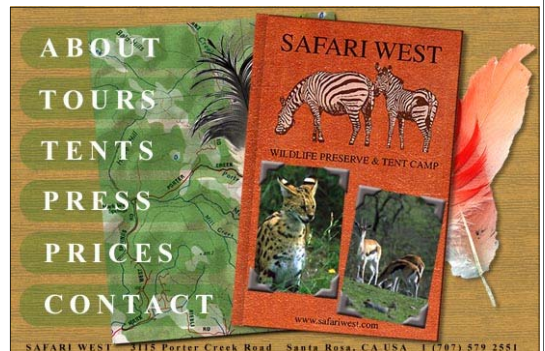

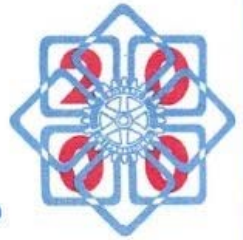

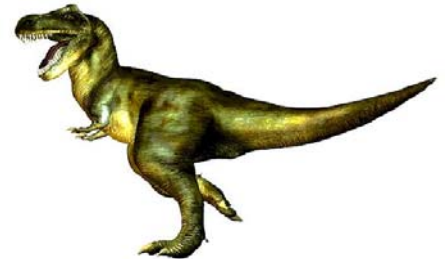

"Evolution of Dinosaurs"

For at least 160 million years dinosaurs roamed our planet. Living, dying and evolving into some of the most fascinating creatures that have ever lived. Then mysteriously 65 Million years ago they became extinct, they vanished off the face of the earth. The cause of this mass extinction is not known for certain, some scientists believe that the dinosaurs died out gradually . The most popular theory is one of a 10km diameter meteor colliding with the earth and causing a huge dust cloud that blocked the sunlight to the earth making the world cold, producing conditions that dinosaurs could not survive. Now all that remain of these "monsters" are fossilised bones, pieced together by scientists to give us an insight to when dinosaurs ruled the earth.

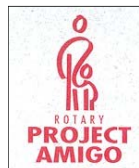

A Thailand/USA Group Study Exchange takes advantage of the District's "Vocation Day" to visit a Pennsylvania local news station.

Since its inception in 1965, the Group Study Exchange program has provided grants for countless teams of men and women in the early stages of their business and professional careers to travel abroad and share vocational information with the representatives of their respective professions in another country. Team members spend four to six weeks studying the host country's institutions, economy, and culture, while observing how their own professions are practiced abroad. More than 500 exchanges between paired Rotary districts occur each year, advancing the program's ultimate goal of promoting international understanding and goodwill. Rotary districts select teams comprising four non-Rotarians and one Rotarian

leader, engaged in different businesses and professions. Each of two paired districts sends and receives a team for a four- to six-week study program. Pairings are usually determined by The Rotary Foundation's trustees to ensure wide geographical distribution, but exchanges can also be arranged by the participating districts.

While visiting abroad, GSE team members follow a carefully planned itinerary, including visits to government and cultural institutions, schools, religious and historic sites and other points of interest. In

addition, each member spends at least five days studying and observing the practice of his or her profession in the host district.

The Foundation grant funds round-trip air transportation for each team member. Rotarians provide lodging in their homes, meals, and

Rotary International and Global Partners Honored by AMA's Inaugural Dr. Nathan Davis International Award in Medicine and Public Health for 20-Year Effort to Eradicate Polio

(EVANSTON, Ill. — 10 June 2000) Chicago-area based Rotary International is the first to accept the American Medical Association's (AMA) award for Outstanding Global Health Initiative on behalf of the global partnership to eradicate polio. In addition to Rotary, global public partners also recognized include the World Health Organization (WHO), UNICEF and the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

The award, presented to Rotary President Carlo Ravizza at a gala banquet held in association with the AMA's Annual Meeting of the House of Delegates on June 10th in Chicago, honors physicians and health initiatives that further health information and medical practice worldwide. Named for the founder of the AMA, the awards advance an eleven-year tradition of the Dr. Nathan Davis Awards Program into the international arena. With the presentation of these awards, the AMA strives to encourage and stimulate international recognition for the highest standards of service that advance the well-being of all.

"I am deeply honored to receive this award on behalf of our global partners," said Rotary President Carlo Ravizza. "Today we are at the forefront of victory in the fight to eradicate this crippling and tragic disease. As a result of this initiative, three million children worldwide who might otherwise have fallen victim to polio are today walking, running and playing."

Carol Bellamy, Executive Director of UNICEF who also attended the ceremony said, "This honor recognizes the great importance of a truly global partnership. Polio eradication requires unprecedented teamwork and we are only as effective as the weakest link in the chain. Because the importance of the goal is embraced worldwide, every link is strong and victory is in sight."

Within the last decade, the number of polio cases has been reduced by over 90 percent. Endemic on five continents in 1988, polio today strikes children in sub-Saharan Africa and South Asia.

"We now stand on the brink of consigning this disease to the history books forever. The efforts here in the Americas have been an inspiration for the worldwide effort. This

Applicants must be between the ages of 25 and 40 and employed full-time, with a minimum of two-years experience, in a recognized business or profession. In addition, candidates should have some proficiency in the language of the country to which they intend to travel, must be exemplary in their business or professional conduct, enthusiastic about their vocations, and capable of deriving maximum educational value from the program. After their study abroad, participants are expected to speak about their experiences at Rotary meetings and other civic functions.

Interested applicants should contact their local Rotary club for application materials and information regarding deadlines.

award is a great boost to the many individuals who are working around the clock to ensure that we seize the window of opportunity to rid the world of this disease," said Tomris Turmon, M.D., Senior Policy Advisor to the Director-General of WHO.

CDC Director Jeffrey Koplan, MD, MPH, said, "The battle to eradicate polio, a crippling disease known since ancient times, has already achieved stunning success. Since the initiative was launched in 1988, three million people in the developing world, who would have been paralyzed, are walking because they have been immunized against polio. The entire population of the world will benefit forever from the hard work and dedication of the individuals who have been



involved in this effort."

To date, Rotary has

contributed US\$373 million to the protection of nearly two billion children. By the year 2005, Rotary's financial commitment will reach nearly half a billion US dollars. In addition, thousands of Rotary volunteers assist in vaccine delivery, social mobilization and logistical help.

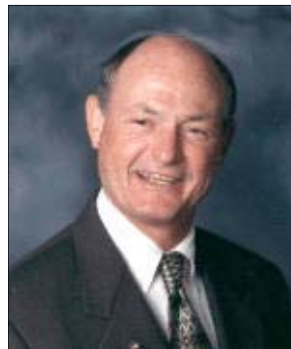


Dear Club Members:

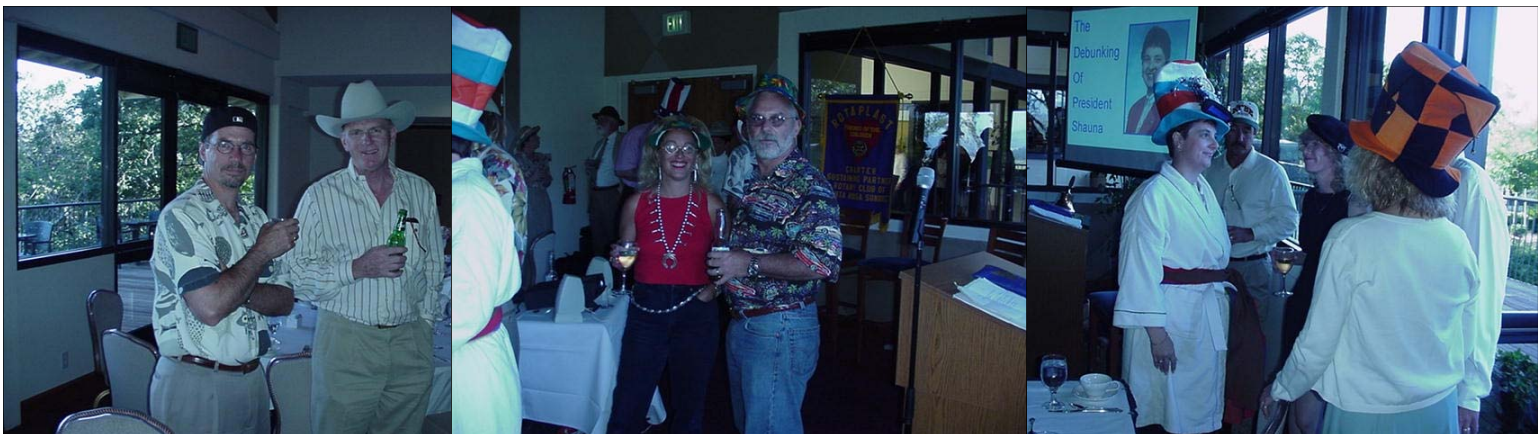
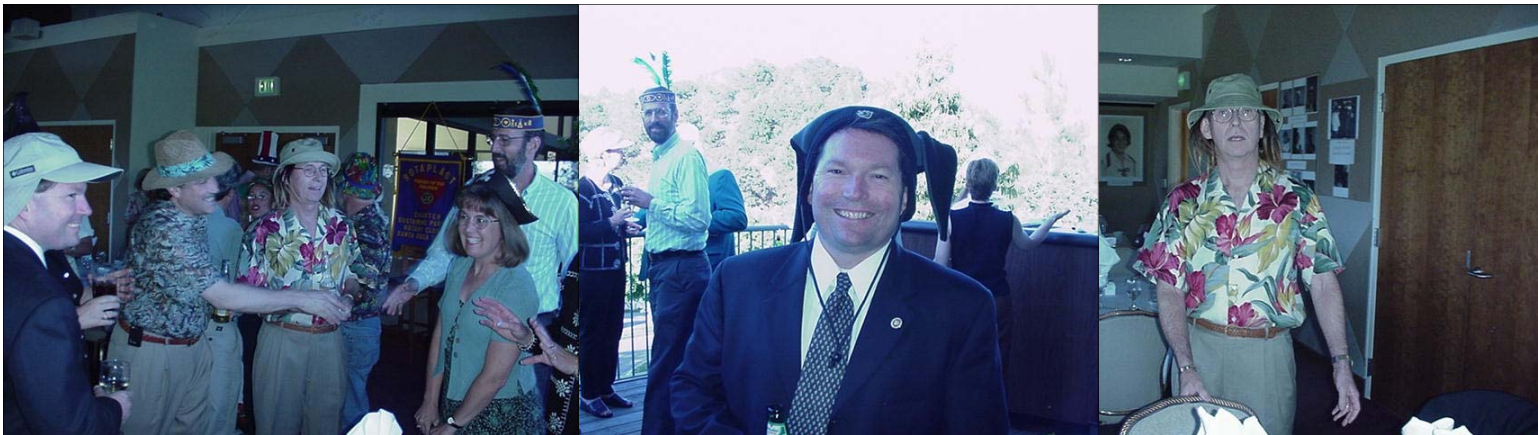
