Anniversary Reflections

- 1911-12** Rotary's "Service Above Self" and "He Profits Most Who Serves Best" mottoes are created, and the first issue of the magazine, *The National Rotarian*, is published
- 1916-17** The Annual Rotary International Convention in Atlanta, Georgia, U.S.A., elected E. Leslie Pidgeon of Canada as Rotary International President. Also in Atlanta, outgoing Rotary International President, Arch Klumph proposed establishing an endowment fund—a forerunner of the Rotary Foundation of R.I.
- 1918-19** Rotary enters South America with the launching of a club in Montevideo, Uruguay. A new hemisphere is open to extension with the chartering of the Rotary Club of Manila, Philippines.
- 1920-21** The convention in Edinburgh, Scotland, is the first held outside the U.S. This convention also adopts International peace and goodwill as one of the Objects of Rotary.
- 1923-24** The first House of Friendship is instituted at the R.I. Convention in Toronto, Ontario, Canada.
