### Request For Assistance:

The Rotary Club of Mad River is currently working on a project with an international aid organization, **Love Without Borders**, to send medical supplies to Bosnia. They have requested help from us, and all Rotary Clubs in the area, to gather supplies to send. Specifically, they are requesting *used* wheelchairs, prosthetic devices, and baby formula. The Mad River club will be picking up all donated items and arranging for their delivery to a trucking company in SF. **The pickup will happen around April 10th.** From there, the supplies will be trucked to New York, and loaded on a shipping container sent to Split, Croatia, for further transport to hospitals in Mostar and Sarajevo.
