
### Important Announcements: Annual Golf Tournament:

is scheduled for June 12th-20th. This will be our third eyeglass project abroad.







### Andy Berliner of Amy's Kitchen

Andrew Berliner is the founder, President and CEO of Amy's Kitchen, a producer of frozen vegetarian foods made from organically grown ingredients. Andy started off selling encyclopoedias during his sophomore year at Purdue. He moved to Australia at age 22 to work for and eventually become president of a small cosmetics



firm which he helped build into a multimillion dollar business. After returning to the U.S. (Northern California) in 1974 he worked for and became President of Magic Mountain Herbal Teas. Within 4 years, annual sales jumped from \$35,000 to \$12 million. Andy then turned his attention to his brother's Old Chicago Pizza Restaurant in Petaluma, and he marketed individual "Chicago Style" frozen pizzas in grocery stores, introducing vegetarian "Old Chicago Pizzas" into the natural foods marketplace. This venture did not prosper but the experience provided the basis for the establishment of Amy's Kitchen, a truly prospering business, which Andy will tell us about.
