Santa Rosa Sunrise Members...



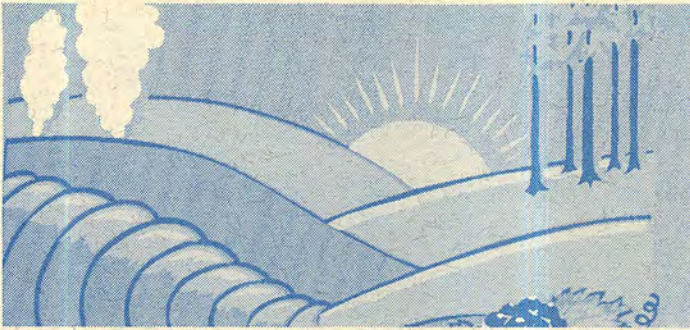

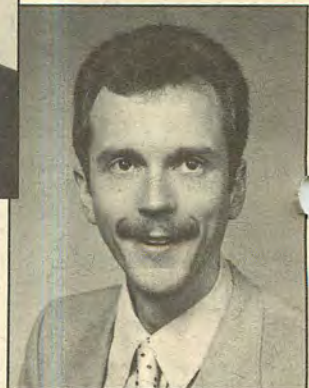

To date we have received \$4,680.00 for ticket sales. Net profit is \$1100.00 and I expect we will be having more money trickle in.

Total attendance was 368. Of the 368, 90 were gate sales. This means we had total tickets sales of 278 by the club, or 4.63 per member.

Actually my best guess is that of our 60 members, we had 25 who sold no tickets at all. All in all I'd say that this is pretty poor participation.

I think we all agree that this is a good event and should be an easy way for us to raise money. If we do it twice a year we should be able to raise close to \$5,000.

For future Scandia Family Fun Nights I suggest the following:

- 1) Set a sales goal of 500 tickets.
- 2) Allow a longer period of time to sell tickets, at a minimum 5 weeks.
- 3) Choose a date with fewer conflicts.
- 4) Force greater club participation in ticket sales. Mandatory sales might be a consideration.
- 5) Track ticket sales by member.

Should these measure not prove successful then perhaps some of the following, more drastic measures may work:

- *Choose one member who has sold no tickets and have them flogged at a meeting. Have Nancy fine them if they whimper.*
- *Choose one member with no tickets sales and make them eat the entire pan of scrambled eggs in front of the club.*
- *Make a member with no ticket sales watch more of Bob Jarvis's slides.*
- *Have one member who has sold no tickets dress up in a bear suit and run around in front of Leroy's house.*

Seriously, I believe this is a good event and with better planning and greater club participation it should be an easy money maker for us. Assuming we choose to do Scandia again, I would like to have the opportunity to chair the event.

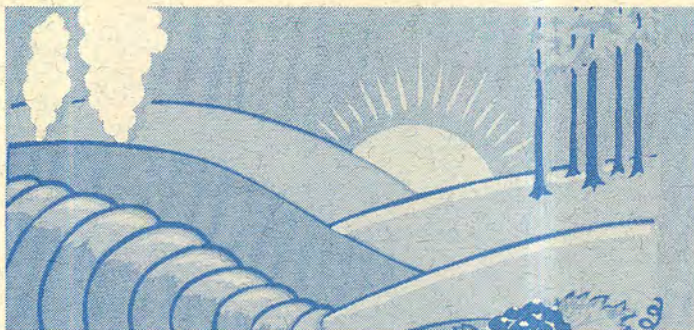

Dear Sunrise Rotary Club; Bonjour Tout le monde! Comment Ca Va? Moi, tout va tres bien! I just got back from a two week mini-exchange in Madeira, Portugal. I never realized that the island was closer to Morocco than Portugal. I really am lucky to be in Europe this year, because of the open borders and the community EUROPEAN. My school has been participating in group exchanges with other countries in the community such as Portugal, Denmark, Germany, Holland, England, Ireland, France and Italy. Being the only exchange student in my school also has many advantages. I went to Madeira with the senior class, we spent two weeks on the beautiful, semi-tropical island, in the homes of the participating students. We spent the first week touring the island and enjoying the sun (which has just begun to appear again in Belgium) it was the weeks vacation of Carnival so I was able to experience Carnival Brazilian style! During that whole week they played Brazilian samba music in the streets day in and day out. It was very festive! We also were able to watch a fantastic parade that lasted over 3 hours. The costumes were exceptional, each group had a different theme and music which they danced to in their colorful outfits. The Belgians and I were really taken in. The second week we accompanied our host students to school. We took classes only in Portuguese and French. We gave a presentation on Belgium and then had a cheese and beer tasting for the students. I must say the beer tasting made me realize I was in Europe. Of course I didn't try any! Well, I must say that I am very privileged to take part in these school/mini-exchanges. I was really able to see and experience another culture and lifestyle. The week that we got back I was able to participate in a second exchange which was for 3 days in Paris, again in the houses of participating students. This was a sports exchange - I went along with the 8th, 9th, and 10th graders and the gym teacher. We had a "little" competition against the parisians which unfortunately we lost. We had a field hockey tournament, 1/2 hour swimming relay, a water polo match, 300 meter running race, a shot put and a long jump competition. Although we lost, I enjoyed very much experiencing parisian life in a small way. I really noticed a difference in the accent and in mannerisms. They also had many expressions that Belgians don't use and vice versa. For example, the Belgians use the term une chique for chewing gum, so when I offered a parisian a piece of gum, I asked her if she would like une chique. Well surprisingly, she look shocked and asked me to repeat myself. Thinking I must have pronounced it wrong I said again Tu veux une chique? and I brought out the package to show her. Well, it turns out that chique to the French means chewing tobacco. I must say that I've been completely enjoying my ear. I want to thank you all again for making this possible. I am looking forward to showing you all my photos which will add color and life to my descriptions. I hope you all are doing well. Oh! I changed host families. My new address is Rue Elie Belanger 47, 7350 Thulin - Belgique. They are also terrific people who unfortunately have a ... yes a restaurant! I eat well in Belgium, let me tell you! Gros bisous!
