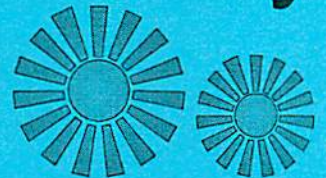
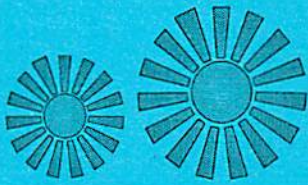

Russ announced that John Watson and Ralph Harryman have volunteered to develop a small garden plot at the Living Room. The Living Room provides a safe place for homeless

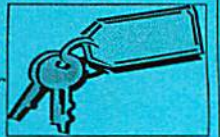
mothers and their children during the day. There are toys for the children and other services available.

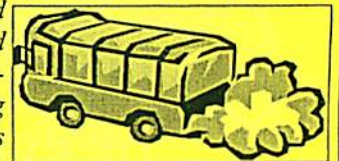
Meeting of May 27
