Muza's goal is to attend the San Francisco Conservatory of Music Master's program beginning in September, 1994. To qualify for acceptance she must first pass the TOEFL exam to prove her competency in English and then perform satisfactorily in an audition of piano music in April, 1994. Muza's immediate needs, in addition to some friends and some money:

- 1.) A place to stay that will provide room and board in exchange for services that Muza may be able to provide. (Until December 10 when school is over, her time is somewhat limited.)
 - 2.) Daily transportation to Sonoma State or to a bus than can get her to school. (She does have a driver's license but no car and no resources to support a car and the required insurance.)
 - 3.) From Dec. 10 to April 11, access to a piano and at least 4 hours a day for practice for the admissions audition. During this time, she would have considerable time to work and try to save some money for school.
 - 4.) After the audition until school starts, an opportunity to work to support herself and pay for school.
 - 5.) Help with visa status & possible political asylum.

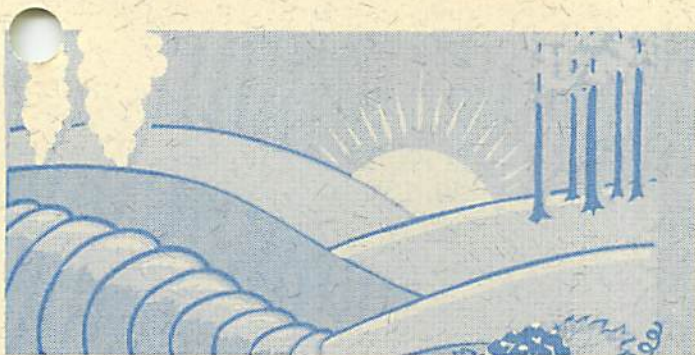
