# SUNRISE ROTARY

## NEW MEMBERS POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

### I. NEW MEMBER POLICIES

- A. The primary policy of the Club is to approve members who will be worthy additions to the Club, and who meet the requirements of membership as outlined in the Club's constitution.
- B. It is the policy of the Club that the classification of a proposed member should accurately reflect their primary business activity.
- C. It is not appropriate for a club member to object to admission of a proposed member solely because this proposed member is in direct competition with an existing member's business.
- D. Sunrise Rotary will continue to follow the 10% limit on "categories" of members.

### II. NEW MEMBER PROCEDURES

- A. Existing member obtains new member application card from Club Secretary.
- B. Completed application is forwarded to Club Classification Chair who verifies classification. Letter approving or disapproving is forwarded to Club Membership Chair.
- C. If classification is approved, membership committee performs due diligence on proposed member. If classification is full, application is denied.
- D. After due diligence, membership committee prepares a letter to the Board of Directors with recommendation.
- E. Board of Directors will discuss proposed member at their Board meeting. They will either approve, not approve or refer back to membership committee for further work.
  - 1. If approved, sponsor notifies new member to confirm their desire to join club. If yes, name is given to bulletin editor for 2 week publishing period.
  - 2. If not approved, procedure stops.
- F. An orientation meeting is scheduled for the proposed new member and attended by they proposed new member, sponsor and at least one person from the Membership Committee. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the Rotary organization and history, and Club obligations. At this meeting, the proposed member is asked

## II. NEW MEMBER PROCEDURES (Continued)

permission to publish their name in the bulletin. See attached "New Member Orientation" outline.

- G. During the 2 week publishing period, if a member-at-large objects to the proposed member, they should write a letter outlining their objections and forward it to the Board for their discussion at a Board meeting. The objecting member(s) and Membership Committee Chairperson may be asked to attend the Board meeting. The Board will consider the objection at their next meeting and make a final decision.
- H. The proposed new member must attend three (3) club meetings as a guest of their sponsor. The sponsoring member should:
  - 1. Always be at the meeting early to greet your guest when he/she arrives.
  - 2. Be financially responsible for guest/proposed member. This obligation ceases after membership induction meeting.
  - 3. When introducing the guest each week, tell the membership something about guest; occupation, name of business, location, specialty, hobbies, family, etc. A guest should not be introduced as a prospective member of a person who is visiting the club for a third time. Such an introduction could lead to embarrassment later.
  - 4. Prior to each meeting, introduce your guest to a couple of members not met previously, Also, sit with a different group each week.
- I. If the proposed new member desires to join the Club, the Membership Committee notifies the Club President who schedules the induction at an upcoming meeting.

## III. INDUCTION PROCEDURE AT CLUB

- A. Membership committee person welcomes and presents new member with Club Directory and Red Badge
- B. Sponsor introduces and presents new member with Rotary Pin and Club Handbook
- C. President welcomes and presents new member with Framed Object of Rotary Certificate
- D. New member presents one minute acceptance speech
- E. NEW MEMBER is responsible for paying dues, initiation and Paul Harris no later than this first meeting.

#### IV. RED BADGE TO BLUE BADGE

The Membership Committee will monitor red badge to blue badge requirements of the new member. It is expected the new member will complete these requirements in a reasonable amount of time, usually no more than 3 months. It is the sponsor's obligation to help the new member through this process.

The requirements are as follows:

1. Collect 30 business cards from members
2. Introduce visiting Rotarians
3. Attend 1 Board meeting
4. 1 committee assignment and attendance
5. 1 Mystery Rotarian Craft-talk
6. 1 make-up with sponsor at another club
7. Door Greeter for 2 weeks (contact Sergeant at Arms)
8. Provide passport size picture for Directory and new member questionnaire
9. Attend 1 fireside meeting

Once all procedures have been completed, the Club President is notified by the Membership Committee. The President arranges for the new member and sponsor to be at a meeting where the sponsor will present the new member with a blue badge.
