



John Blount is a twenty-two year member and past president of the Sebastopol Rotary Club. He was Governor of District 5130 and its 36





involvement in Community Service. Community Service includes the scope of activities which Rotarians undertake to improve the quality of life in their community. Many official Rotary programs are intended to meet community needs, whether it be to promote literacy, help the elderly or disabled, combat urban violence or provide opportunities for local youth.

Rotary's first Community Service project took place in 1907, when Paul Harris led a campaign to have public comfort stations installed at the city hall in Chicago, Illinois. The campaign was successful in spite of opposition from saloons and department stores that provided these facilities to attract customers.

These early Rotarians were beginning to shape the characteristics and principals of Rotary's Third Avenue of Service.

The following is a proposed amendment to ARTICLE IX of the by-laws of The Rotary Club of Santa Rosa Sunrise.

(Changes noted in <u>underlined italic</u>)

Upon written application to the Board of Directors, <u>describing a specific medical or health related condition including the duration of the requested absence from meetings</u>, a leave of absence may be granted excusing a member from attending the meetings of the club for a specific length of time.

If a member has a temporary, non-medical situation which would prevent them from regular attendance of club meetings, the member may request a special leave of absence by making a written application which shall be presented by the member in person at a regularly scheduled board meeting. Under such circumstances, the member may be granted a special leave of absence for a pre-set length of time, but would be expected to participate in the ongoing functions of the club (i.e. work parties, committee assignments).

As required in the Club By-Laws, any change to the By-Laws must be voted on by the membership at a regularly scheduled meeting (December 9) and notice of any proposed By-Law change must be made available to the membership at least two weeks in advance.






