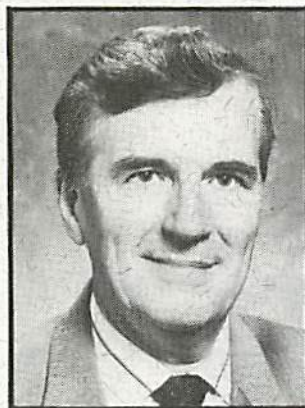

FOUNDATION FACTS

Do all of you remember "PolioPlus"? This is still an ongoing Foundation project!

Q. What is PolioPlus?

A. PolioPlus is Rotary's program to provide polio vaccines and mobilize community resources in support of international efforts to immunize the children of the world and to assist, eventually, in the eradication of poliomyelitis from the world. Rotary will provide needed polio vaccines for five years for any approved national or regional immunization program.

Q. Why was polio chosen as the principal target?

A. Each year polio kills 20,000 children and permanently cripples 200,000 more. Treatment and rehabilitation of those crippled by polio is only partially effective at best, and is beyond the means of many developing countries where polio is most widespread. Prevention, however, is inexpensive: approximately US15-20 cents will purchase enough vaccine to protect a child from polio in most cases.

Q. What does "Plus" mean, in the term "PolioPlus"?

A. When polio is eradicated, that will be the biggest "plus." By providing polio vaccines, Rotary helps to accelerate immunization programs that address five other vaccine-preventable diseases as well. Such programs also draw public attention to other aspects of maternal and child health and, ultimately, strengthen the entire basic health care system.
