





Francesa Giovannini, Italy

Over the last five years, Francesca has served in many international organizations in the Arab Region. In 2000, she served in the Gaza Strip (Rafah) as project coordinator, for a joint-initiative of the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Network of Italian NGO's. She then worked for "Un Ponte per..." an Italian NGO, as Desk Officer for projects in Turkey and Lebanon undertaking missions in the field to monitor and evaluate the implementation of humanitarian projects. In October 2002, Francesca was selected by UNDP and appointed as UN Coordination Analyst in Beirut to support and facilitate aid-coordination among UN Agencies.

At UC Berkeley Francesca is exploring the root-causes of major conflicts in the Arab Region, the flourishing of Islamic political movements, and the major threats posed by Islamic Fundamentalism to international security.

After the completion of her Master's program, she would like to go back to the UN as a political advisor for the Middle East. Francesca graduated from the Faculty of Political Sciences in Bologna and continued her

studies in Rome with a postuniversity degree at SPICeS, School of Foreign Affairs, Cooperation and Development. This program offered a variety of lectures mainly on Humanitarian Affairs, Development, and Aid Coordination. In June 2004, while she was already working at the United Nations Development Program Office in Beirut, Francesca attended the summer school in Oslo on Peace Studies:





Benjamin Herbert Floriani, who friends said had been attending San Francisco State University, was found dead on the living-room floor of the Blair Place apartment, according to Santa Rosa police Sgt. Lisa Banayat.

Ben was a 2004 graduate from Analy High School. He was named to the 2006 dean's list in the college of business at San Francisco State, according to the school's Web site. From Peter Hoberg;

Dear Sunrise Rotary friends,

Shauna, Penny, and I visited Don at his home today. Both Don and Wendy are struggling with the death of their oldest son Ben. But there is a great deal of support coming from friends, family, and Rotarians. Don told us again how much that support is helping right now. Don has two brothers and a sister. Don's brother Ron is taking on many of the difficult details, and he will be at their home all week.

If you plan to visit, here are some thoughts: You may feel more comfortable visiting along with someone, such as another Rotarian. You can bring something, but it is not necessary. There is a lot of food at the house now, and also a lot of visitors. The food is as much for the visitors as for the family. Food will be welcomed, but is not required.

Arrangements for services have not yet been made.

Several club members have suggested various ways the club could support the family, and these will continue to be discussed. At this time, the continued individual expressions of encouragement and support for the Floriani family are being greatly appreciated.
