



Last week's program on Radiology & what is happening in Radiology was very interesting & informative. Since the start of the magnetic resonance scanning program in 1985 at Redwood Radiology. approx. 5000 cases have been reviewed. MRI is used mostly as a diagnostic tool for the treatment of tumors in the brain & spinal area. It helps surgeons better analyze the size and location of the

problem so that when they operate to remove the tumor or other problem, there are no surprises.

The exam costs from \$650 to \$1000 and approx. 50 pictures are developed & given to the surgeon or diagnostician. The person to be treated must be less than 300 lbs. & able to pass through a narrow tunnel on a gurney.
