A PERSONAL NOTE FROM THE EDITOR:

I have recently had to confront the unpleasant realization that my days of blissful ignorance of some of the problems here in Santa Rosa are at an end. Because Shirley and I have no children of our own, it has always been easy to avoid reading those articles in the paper that dealt with the problems in the school systems, the problems with gangs, and with violence and drugs in the streets and around our schools. If I did read them, I only got depressed about it and figured it was not my problem or that I couldn't do anything about it anyway. I guess that is the denial that Police Chief Rosano talked about last week. For the last two weeks we have been host parents to a wonderful 17 year old girl from Croatia and the experience has already sharpened our consciousness of the lives we have created for our kids. It is a profound experience to have to wonder if this child, this small part of our collective future, is at greater risk here in high school, on the campus, or on the street in Santa Rosa, California, than she is in Zagreb, Croatia, the capital city of a country at war. There, it is a one hour trip to school, walking and by tram, through Croatians, Serbians, and Bosnians, Catholic, Eastern Orthodox and Muslim and in a city pressed beyond patience with refugees. I don't know the answer to the question but I do know I wish it weren't so hard to answer or so hard to ask.

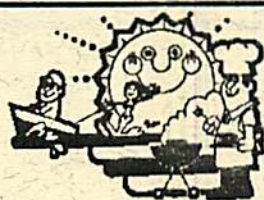
