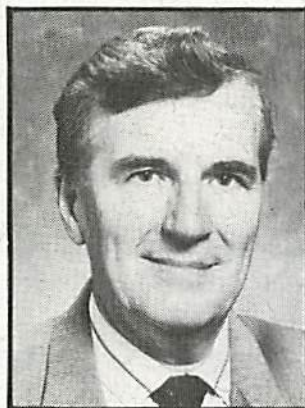

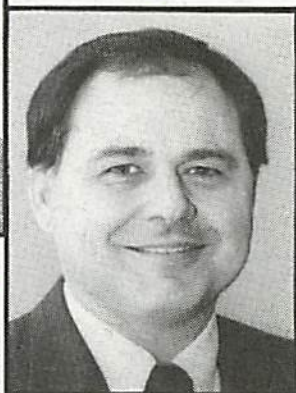

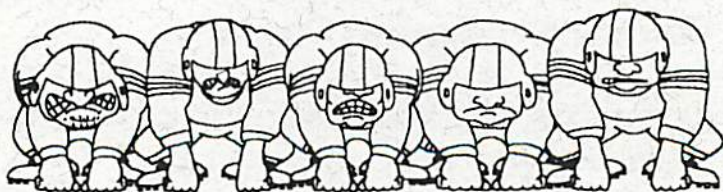
LIGHT RECOGNITION THIS WEEK AS WE ARE IN THE MIDST OF THE RFL!

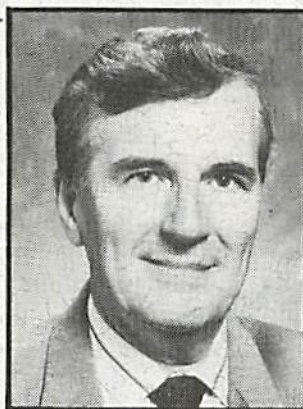

STEPS TO PROPOSING A NEW MEMBER

by John Dolinsek

1. Obtain a membership proposal card from our Club Secretary.
2. Complete proposal card and submit to our Classification Chair for review and processing.
3. After Classification Committee has assessed the availability of an open classification for the proposed new member, the application will then be forwarded to the Membership Chair.
4. The Membership Committee will then prepare a report for the Board of Directors' review at a regularly scheduled monthly meeting. As the proposer of a new member, it is your obligation to attend the board meeting to discuss with the Board the prospective new member.
5. During this process, you may bring your proposed member to meetings and introduce him/her to the general membership each time, telling the membership something new either professionally or personally about your particular guest.
6. The Membership Committee will then send to the Board of Directors a recommendation for approval. After Board approval, an orientation meeting will be scheduled. It is the proposer's responsibility to attend the membership orientation meeting with the proposed new member.
7. The proposed new member's name will be published in the bulletin for a two week period providing a time for which the general membership may oppose membership by writing a letter to the Board of Directors specifically stating reasons for opposition.
8. After the two week period has cleared, the sponsor will be contacted by the Membership Chair requesting that he/she bring his/her proposed member to the club for induction and presentation of Red Badge.
9. During the next 6-8 weeks, it is the sponsor's commitment to help the new Red Badge member obtain his/her Blue Badge and assist in any way possible. It is essential that the sponsor work closely with the Membership Committee during this process.

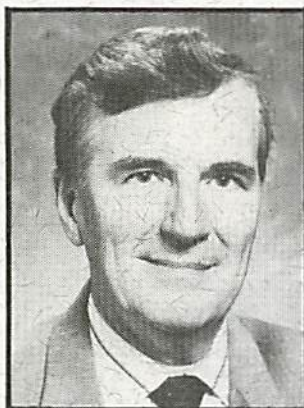


FOUNDATION FACTS



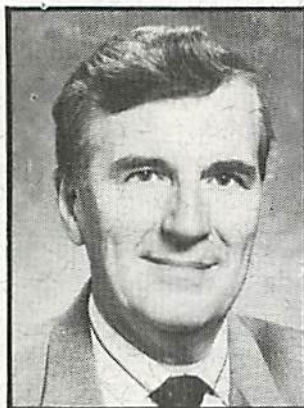

FOUNDATION FACTS

Foundation Group Study Exchange (GSE)

The Group Study Exchange promotes world peace and understanding through GSE teams of business leaders going to a host foreign country.

Q. Who can become a member of a Group Study Exchange (GSE) team?

A. A GSE team may consist of five non-Rotarian business or professional people and a Rotarian team leader, or four professional or business people, a team leader and his or her spouse. A district may select a team composed of all men, all women, or both men and women.

Q. How long is a GSE study tour?

A. Four to six weeks.

Q. When can a district apply for a GSE award?

A. A district can apply for a GSE award every year. Districts must note, however, that applying does not ensure that the district will be awarded a GSE, since appropriate pairings cannot always be found.

Q. How can a district obtain a second GSE award?

A. Upon mutual agreement, two districts may list each other as first choice. The Trustees will make every effort to grant such an award, but districts should be prepared to accept the pairings as assigned.
