



If you are ready for the challenge - and the rewards of living in another land as an student. exchange then you are ready to discover new worlds through Rotary's Youth Exchange program. Each year, local Rotary districts and clubs



worldwide arrange thousands of international youth exchanges for high school-aged students. A primary goal of the program is to foster world understanding by way of intercultural exchange.

There are two principal types of exchanges:

1.Long term exchanges: usually last for an academic year, during which the student lives with more than one family and attends school in the host country.

2.Short term exchanges: vary from several days to several weeks. They often take place when school is not in session and usually do not include an academic program. Short term exchanges usually involve a stay with host family however they can also be organized as international youth camps, which bring together students from many different countries.







CRITERIA FOR YOUTH GRANTS

Amount: Not to exceed \$250 per grant. The grant amount awarded can not represent the entire amount of the program or project cost. That is, the student will be required to obtain other sources of funding from family, other donations or earned monies.

Eligibility: Ant full time student in a Sonoma County high school, continuation school, Santa Rosa Junior College, Sonoma State University, professional or vocational school.

Purpose: To foster and encourage students to participate in programs or projects which will directly benefit them in achieving a career goal and enable them in making a contribution to their specific community. It may be corollary of an existing program: a specific project which requires special equipment, supplies or tools; travel to workshops, seminars or special programs which are of interest and directly related to a state objective.

Procedure: Submittal of an application to the Board of Directors of the Club at least 90 days prior to the requested funding date; include

- 1. A resume.
- 2. A short description of the project, or program.
- 3. The amount requested and the source of additional funds required.
- 4. A one page statement of how participation in this program or receipt of equipment or supplies would benefit the student.
- . Appearance before the Board of Directors.
- 6. Make a short verbal presentation at a regular meeting after completion of the program or project.




